Gap of Practice:	A defined period of discontinuation of clinical experience/ practice in the professional's field of specialization for healthcare professionals who were fulfilling the licensing requirements
Good Standing Certificate (GSC):	A certificate showing evidence that the healthcare professional is competent to practice the profession, has not been found guilty of unprofessional conduct, and that there are no pending or previous disciplinary orders or criminal proceedings against the healthcare professional.
Primary Source Verification (PSV):	A process of validating documents required for licensure from the issuing organization. The process is completed by a third part company
Nomination Letter:	Official offer letter issued by the hiring facility under the emirate of Abu Dhabi; stating the name of the professional and the offered position title.
License:	A permission granted by the Authority to practice a healthcare profession
Privilege:	An entitlements granted to healthcare professional to practice outside their scope based on training/ certification & experience. Some privileges are granted by DOH on the license and others are assigned by the healthcare provider (facility)
Limitation:	A restriction on the license limiting the practice of the healthcare professional -in consideration to patients' safety- based on their provided experience/ scope of work & surgical logbook



Professional Profile

Creating a profile would be the first step into applying for any DOH related service. This is done by logging to [TAMM](#) website (the official portal for all Abu Dhabi Government services) using UAE PASS – following the steps to select the user type (Professional without DOH license)

The **Unique Identification Number (UIN)** would be required to apply for a New Healthcare Professional license. Below are the steps into obtaining it through TAMM.

New Registration

Through this service, healthcare professionals (**with no previous DOH Licenses**) are able to request the issuance of a DOH license to practice in a healthcare facility in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

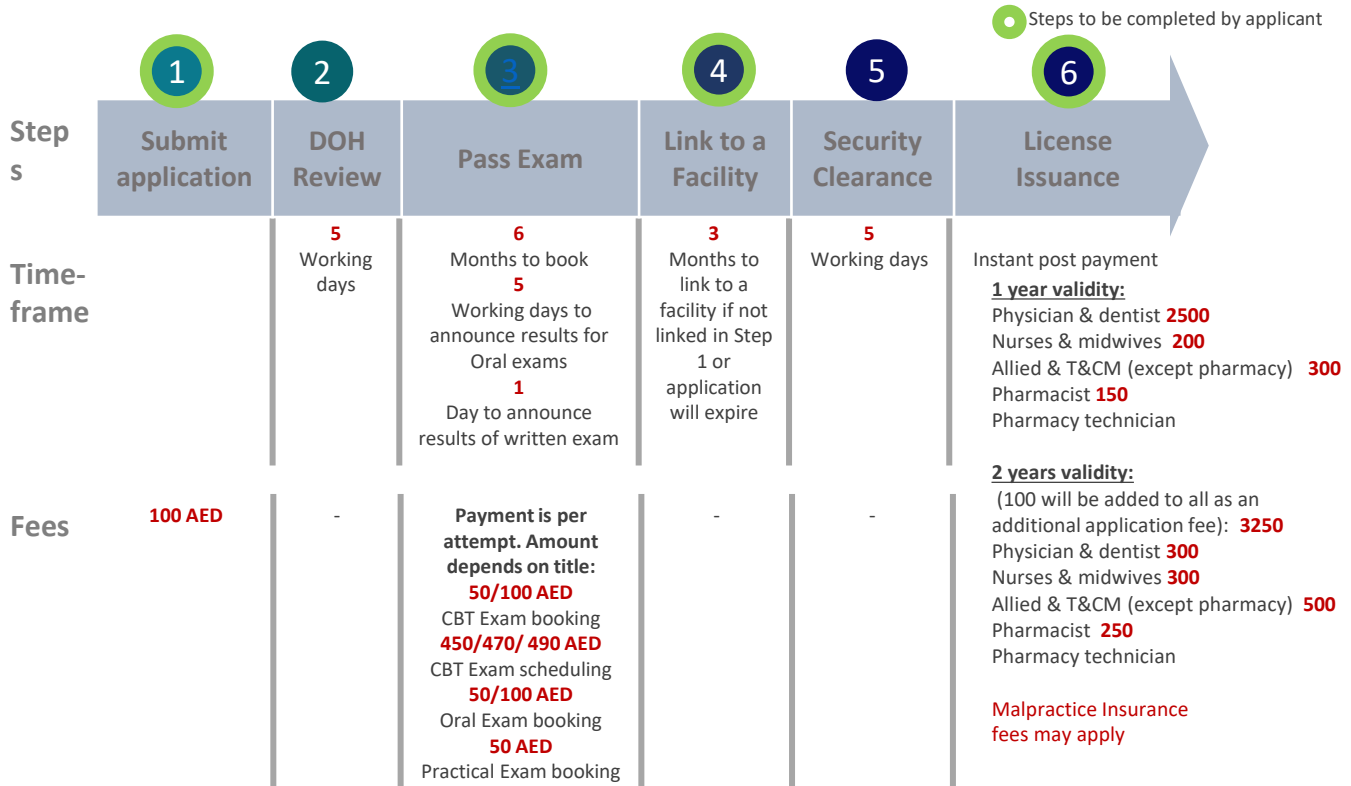

2. Complete the Primary Source Verification (PSV) process of the required documents through the verification agency website – [Link](#). The process time-frame is **24** Working days. The packages prices are: **1,260 AED** General Physician & Dentists, **1,680 AED** Specialists & Consultants & **990 AED** Other Categories

Limitations

- Health facility should be Active and should have the healthcare professional related specialty (vocation)
- Professional must have not failed the assessment for the selected titles more than 4 times (3 times under one UAE health authority and 1 last attempts under another authority)
- Health facility must maintain a valid Medical Malpractice Insurance during the professional practice period

Notes

- If the professional was already linked to a hiring facility in step 1, step 4 will be skipped automatically
- Limitation may be put on the license based on the professional's submitted experience, scope of work & logbook
- The issued license is valid for 2 years
- Based on the nomination letter and fulfilling the criteria, the license type may be Permanent or as Visiting Professional or a Temporary permit



Examination Step

Through this step, the applicant (whether the healthcare professional was applying from his/ her account, or the applications was submitted from the PRO account) is able to book for the required examination to complete the licensure process.

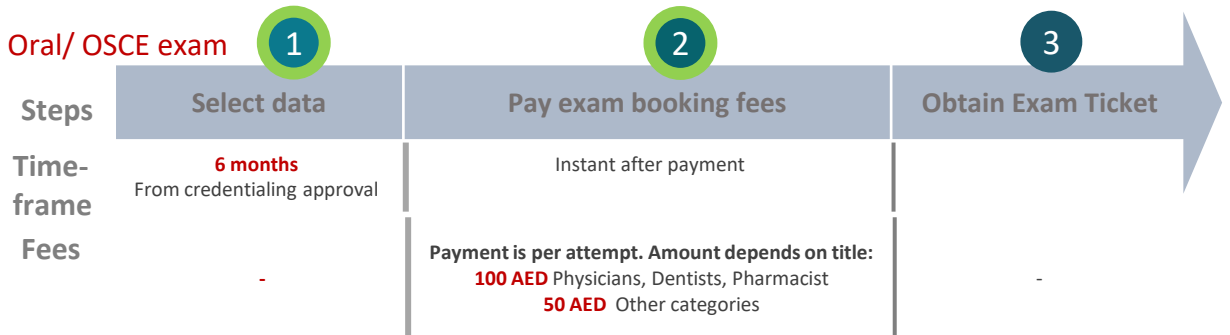
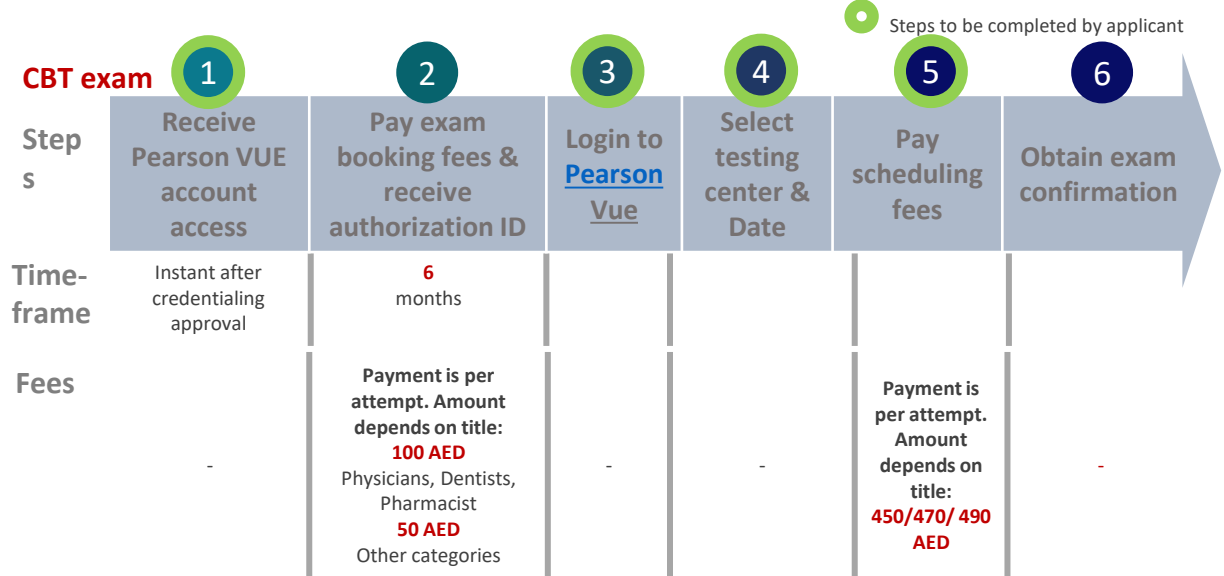

- Approved DOH review step (credentialing) for a New registration, Re-registration or Add, Change & upgrade applications



Requirements

Details regarding exam equivalency (exam exemption) can be found in the [PQR](#)

Documents

The original passport and another form of valid identification that includes a photo of the professional (other government/official identification such as driving license, employment governmental ID)

Limitations

- Applicant must have not failed more than 3 times for the same title across UAE health authorities

Notes

- There is one exam component depending on the requested title (either CBT or Oral). Some titles will have an additional component, which will be stated once the credentials are approved
- All examinations will be conducted in English, and no translator is allowed to attend the oral examination
- Validity of the exam step is 6 months; the application will be automatically closed after. If the exam was not passed during those 6 months, a new application must be submitted
- Exam Duration:
 - CBT exam:** Between 60-180 minutes depending on the requested title as the number of questions will vary
 - Oral & OSCE exam:** 45-60 minutes
- Exam result: Announced as 'PASS' or 'FAIL' on TAMM portal
 - CBT exam:** within 24 hours
 - Oral & OSCE exam:** within 5 working days





Re-Registration

Through this service, **currently or previously DOH Licensed** Healthcare professionals are able to re-register under a healthcare facility in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

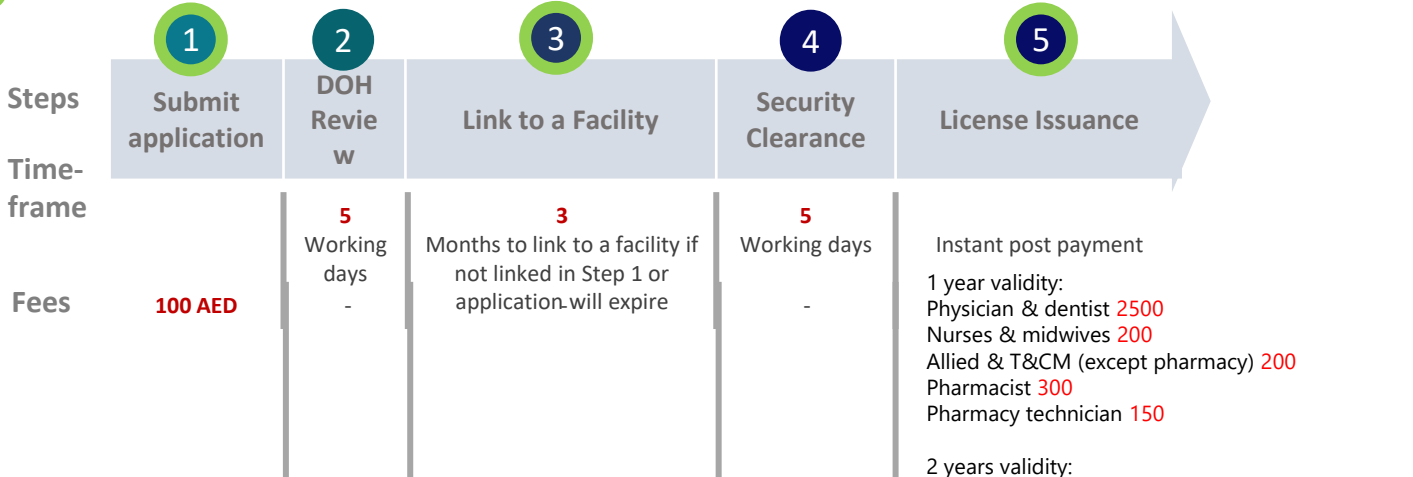

Limitations

- Health facility should be Active and should have the healthcare professional related specialty (vocation)
- Health facility must maintain a valid Medical Malpractice Insurance during the professional practice period
- Based on the nomination letter and fulfilling the criteria, the license type may be Permanent or as Visiting Professional or a Temporary permit
- If upon applying the healthcare professional license was active, once the license issuance fee is paid, a 100 AED will be put on the previous facility as a license cancellation fee
- Passing a [new exam](#) will be required -post step 2- for the following scenarios:
 - The healthcare professional is requesting a new title
 - The healthcare professional DOH license is expired/ cancelled for more than 5 years
 - The healthcare professional is applying after fulfilling the requirements for the Gap of Practice
- If the license was expired upon applying for the service, renewal delay penalties shall apply as follows (per month, up to 6 months):
 - 625 AED for Physicians & Dentist
 - 50 AED for Nurses & midwives
 - 50 AED Allied & T&CM (except pharmacy)
 - 75 AED Pharmacist
 - 37.5 AED Pharmacy technician

Through this service, **currently DOH Licensed** Healthcare professionals are able to re-register under a healthcare facility in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

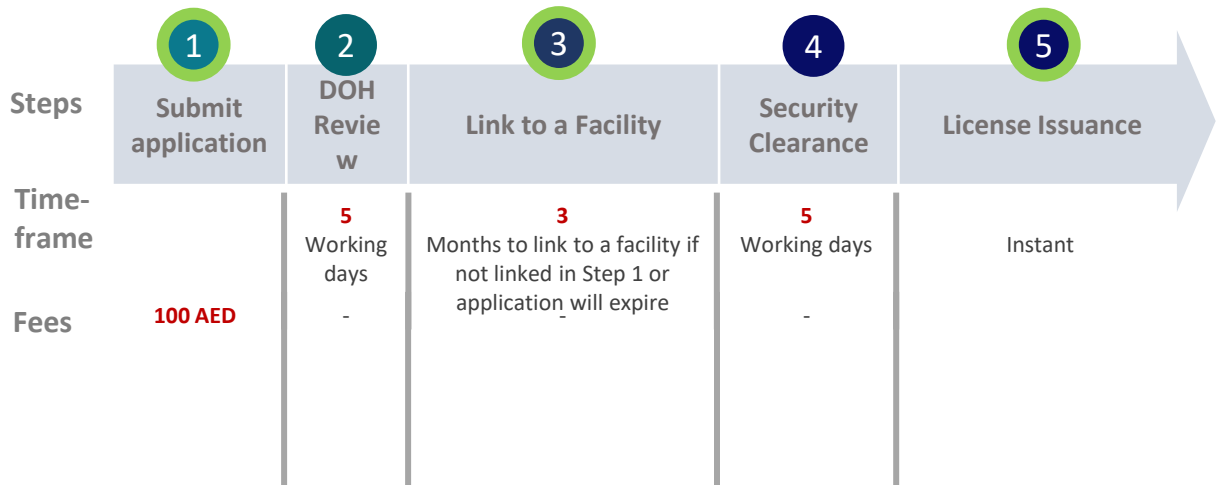

Limitations

- Health facility should be Active and should have the healthcare professional related specialty (vocation)
- Health facility must maintain a valid Medical Malpractice Insurance during the professional practice period
- Active part time/ secondment permits must be cancelled to be able to active the license on a new facility

Notes

- License statues should be Active or About to Expire
- Based on the nomination letter and fulfilling the criteria, the license type may be Permanent or as Visiting Professional or a Temporary permit
- Once the Application is approved the License expiry date will remain the same





Add, Change & Upgrade title

Through this service, the healthcare facility representatives (PRO) are able to request for a title change ,or add additional title/ Privilege for a DOH professional license.

- Educational certificate(s) – if applicable
- Transcript/ residency proof

- For surgical specialties:** Recent 2 years' logbook

Limitations

- Professional license status must not be “about to expire” (2 months before expiry date)
- Professional must be in Good Standing (not Revoked or Suspended)
- The Health facility must have the healthcare professional requested specialty (vocation)

Notes

- The validity of the license will not change
- If the professional have an active Part-time permit or Secondment, those will be cancelled upon issuance of the updated license
- Add privileges to the license (e.g. Dental Implantology, PCR Provider) can be requested through this service
- Upon obtaining the updated license, any active part time permits will be cancelled



Renew License

Through this service, the healthcare facility representatives (PRO) are able to renew the DOH professional license within two months prior to the expiration date.

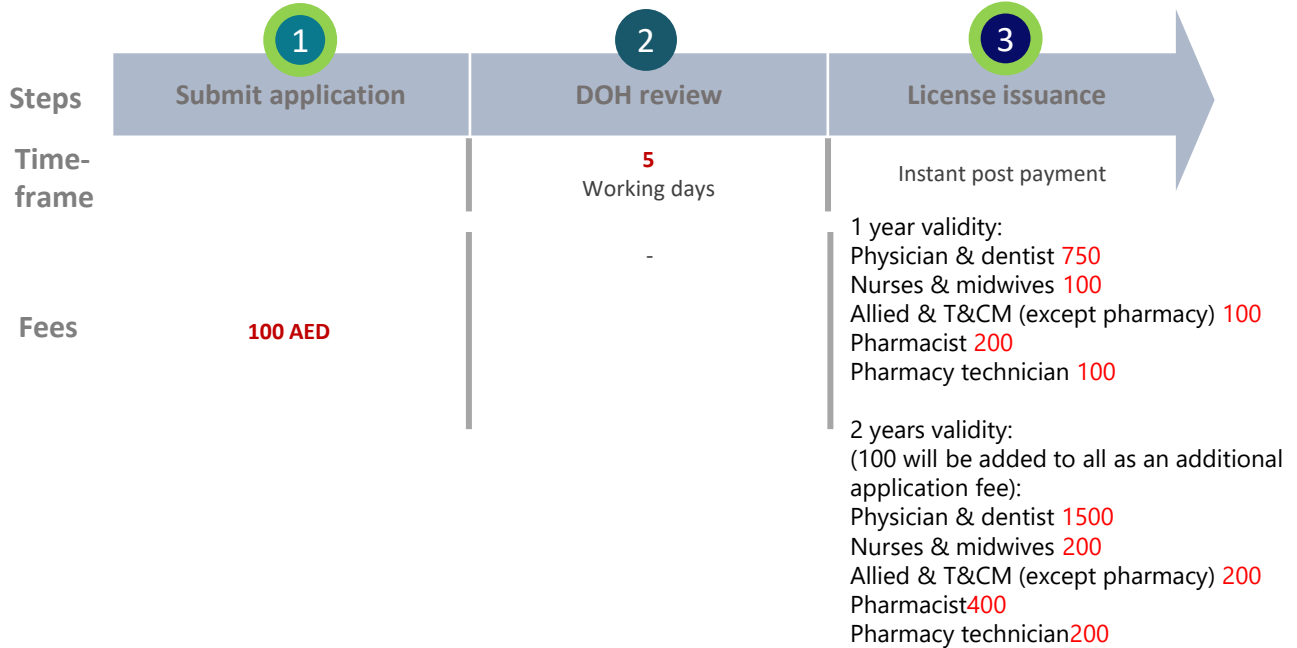

Requirements

1. Valid Passport copy
2. **For surgical specialties:** Recent 2 years' logbook
3. CME/ CPD certificates with clear CME/CPD hours, applicants name and CME/CPD event date:
 - 80 for Physicians and Dentists
 - 40 for Nurses, Midwives and Pharmacists
 - 20 for Allied Health care professionals & Traditional Complementary Medicine Practitioners

Limitations

- License can be renewed within 2 months from the expiry date. Otherwise it will be become expired and a re-registration request must be submitted to re-activate the license (renewal delay penalties shall apply)
- Healthcare professional with suspended licenses cannot apply for renewal
- CME/ CPD certificates must be obtained within the recent 2 years (since last renewal date or initial license issuance date if this was the first renewal cycle for the professional)

Notes

- Renewed licensed will be valid for 2 years from the date of previous expiry
- Limitation may be put on the license based on the professional's submitted logbook
- If the professional have part-time permits, upon license renewal, the permits will be extended to the new license validity date



Cancel License

Through this service, the healthcare professional OR the healthcare facility representative (PRO) are able to cancel the licenses due to resignation.

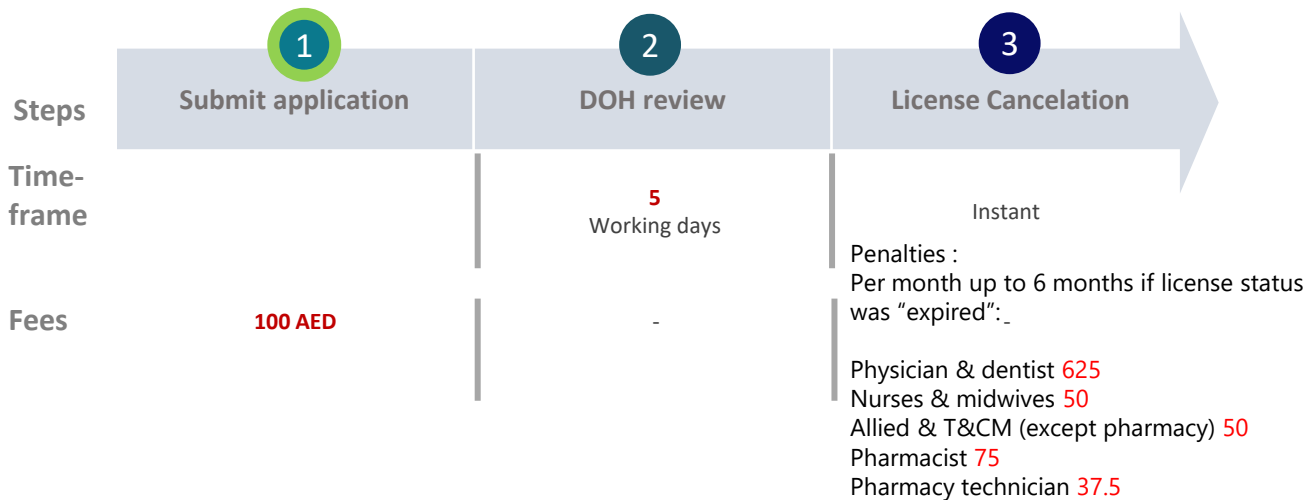

If application is submitted by the healthcare professional:

One of the following must be provided

- NOC to cancel license OR Resignation OR Termination & copy of the facility POA
- Cancelled Visa OR Labor Card from previous facility
- Visa OR Labor Card on a new facility
- MOHRE list with professional name on new facility OR the professional name not listed in previous facility
- Court decision to cancel license

Limitations

- If the professional is the last professional in the facility or the last in the specialty, the facility must hire a new professional before applying for service

Notes

- Cancelling the full time license will lead to cancelation of any pending requests (e.g. Change title request, renewal request).
- If the license was expired upon applying for the service, renewal delay penalties shall apply as follows (per month, up to 6 months):
 - 625 AED for Physicians & Dentists
 - 50 AED for other categories
- Professional license will be cancelled automatically, if the health facility license becomes cancelled by law.



Update Professional Profile

Through this service, the healthcare professional OR the healthcare facility representative (PRO) are able to Update the healthcare professional profile information.

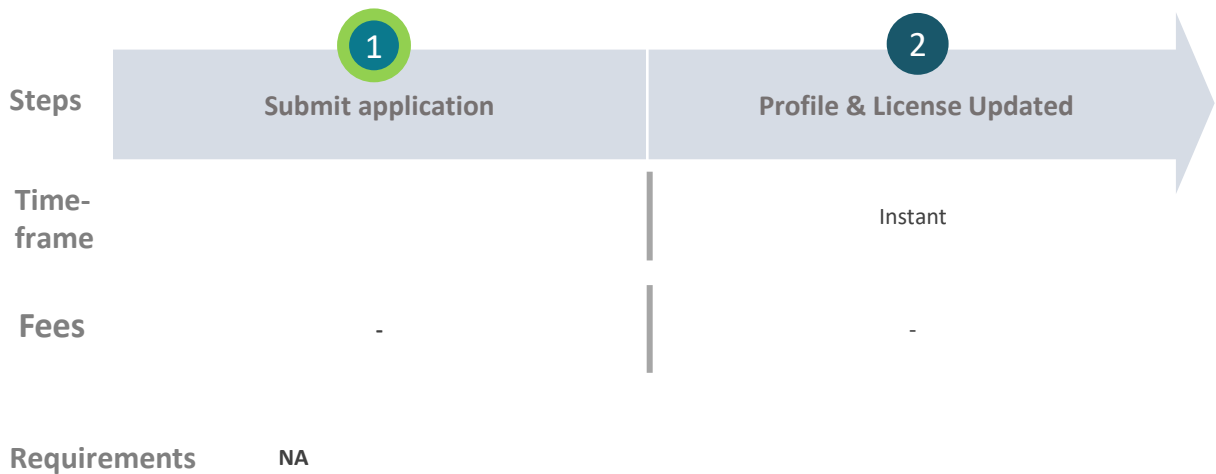

New Part-time Permit

Through this service, the Part-time healthcare facility representative (SPRO) is able to apply for a DOH Licensed Healthcare professional to work as a part-time in a different facility. The approved part-time permit has the same validity as the permanent DOH License

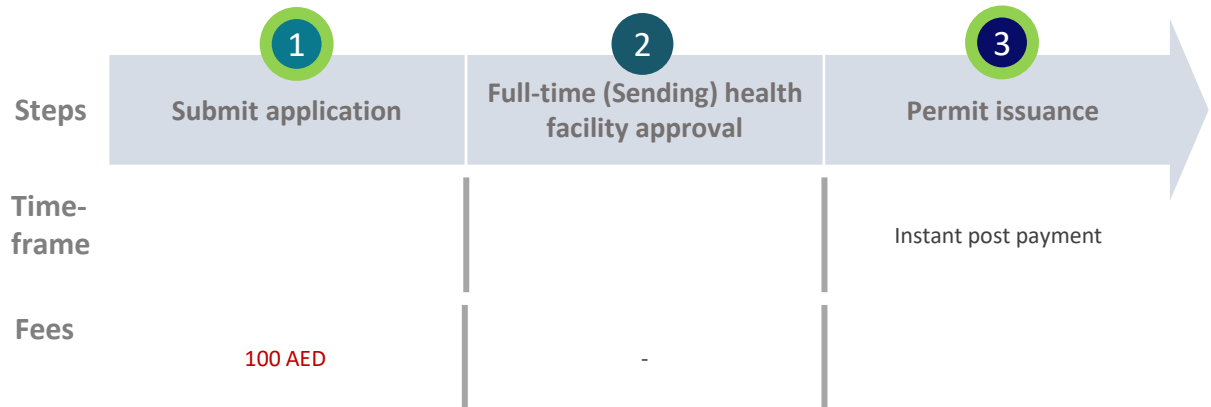

- Only Consultant & Specialist Physician & Dentists may request a Part-time permit
- The specialty (vocation) of the professional must be available in the Part-time (Receiving) health facility.
 - If the professional have multiple titles, as long as the specialty intended for part-time is available at the part-time health facility, the service will be applicable

Notes

- The part-time permit(s) validity is linked to the permanent (full-time) license validity. If the permanent (full-time) license become expired, the part-time permit(s) will be automatically cancelled
- Maximum number of allowed Part-time permits is 2)
- Both the Part-time (Receiving) health facility & the full-time (Sending) health facility can pay the fee for the permit issuance
- To practice within branches of the full-time health facility, the health facility must apply for staff rotation feature and not for a part-time permit
- Staff-rotation between the part-time health facility branches is not permitted





Cancel Part-time Permit

Through this service, the Full-time or Part-time Facility healthcare facility representative (SPRO) is able to apply for a DOH Licensed Healthcare professional to cancel a previously approved permit.

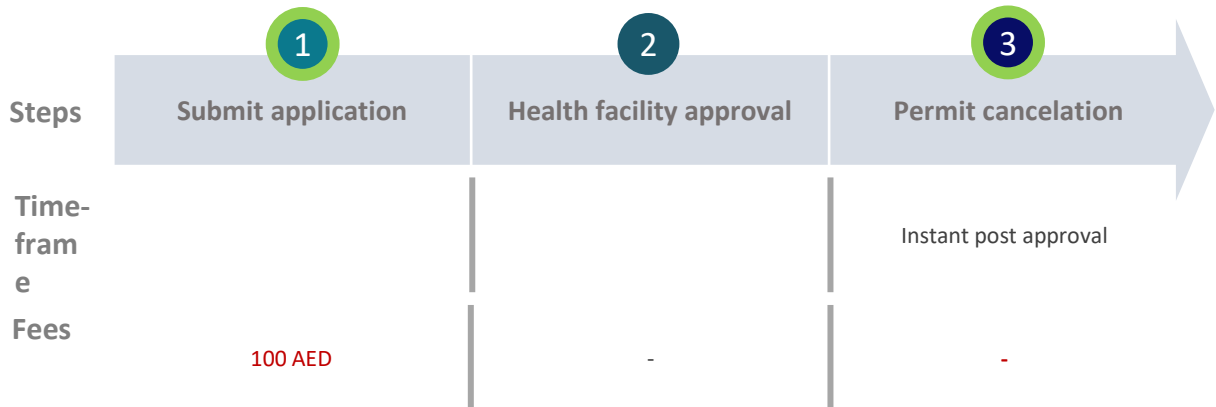

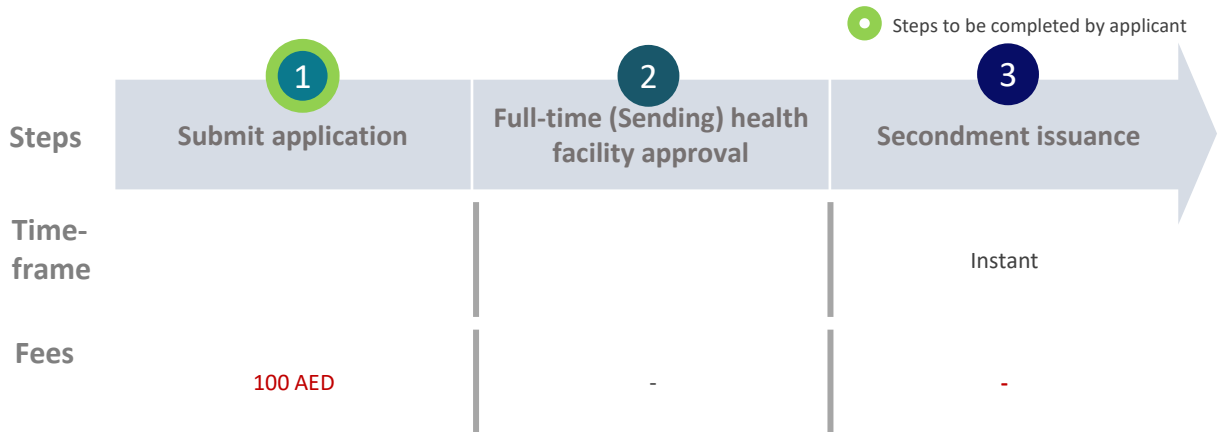

- All healthcare professional categories may request for secondment
- Professional Shall not practice at the Primary Facility during the approved secondment period
- There is no minimum duration or maximum duration for the secondment period (Cannot be extended beyond the permanent license validity)
- The secondment validity is linked to the permanent (full-time) license validity. If the permanent (full-time) license become expired, the secondment will be automatically cancelled





Amend Secondment

Through this service, the healthcare facility representative (SPRO) is able to apply for the secondment cancellation or amendment of the duration.

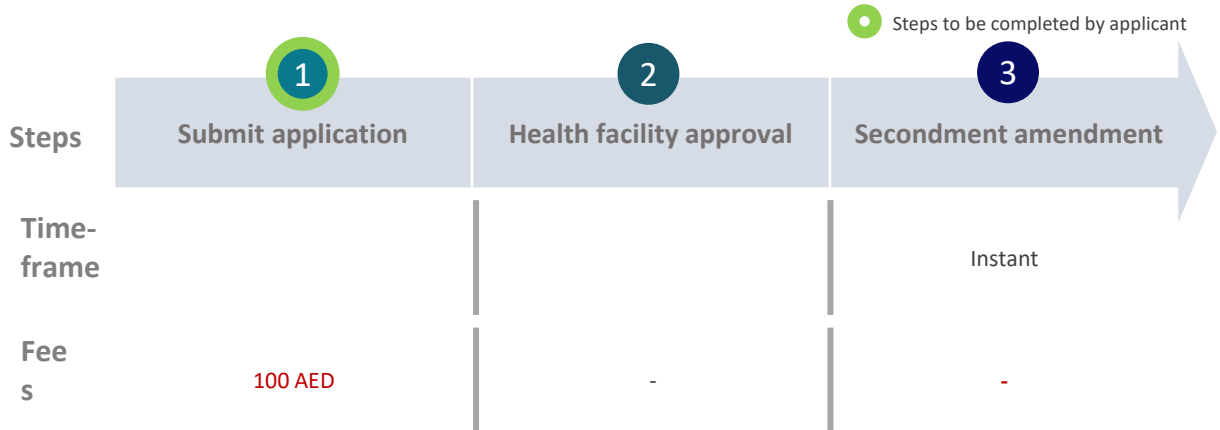

- Healthcare professional is allowed one secondment at a time

Notes

- Depending on the health facility which initiates the request, the other facility must approve in order for the permit to be extended or cancelled.
- There is no limit to the number of times a Secondment extension can be requested
- There is no minimum duration or maximum duration for the secondment period. However, the secondment cannot be extended beyond the permanent license validity (Note: Secondment duration will be validated against the leave balance for Pharmacists in charge)
- Both sending & receiving facility can apply for cancelation and for amendment
- The secondment validity is linked to the permanent (full-time) license validity. If the permanent (full-time) license become expired, the secondment will be automatically cancelled





Request a Current Professional Status Certificate

Through this service, currently or previously DOH Licensed Healthcare professionals are able to apply for a Current professional status certificate (known as a Good Standing Certificate). This indicates the healthcare professional status of practice during the licensed period.

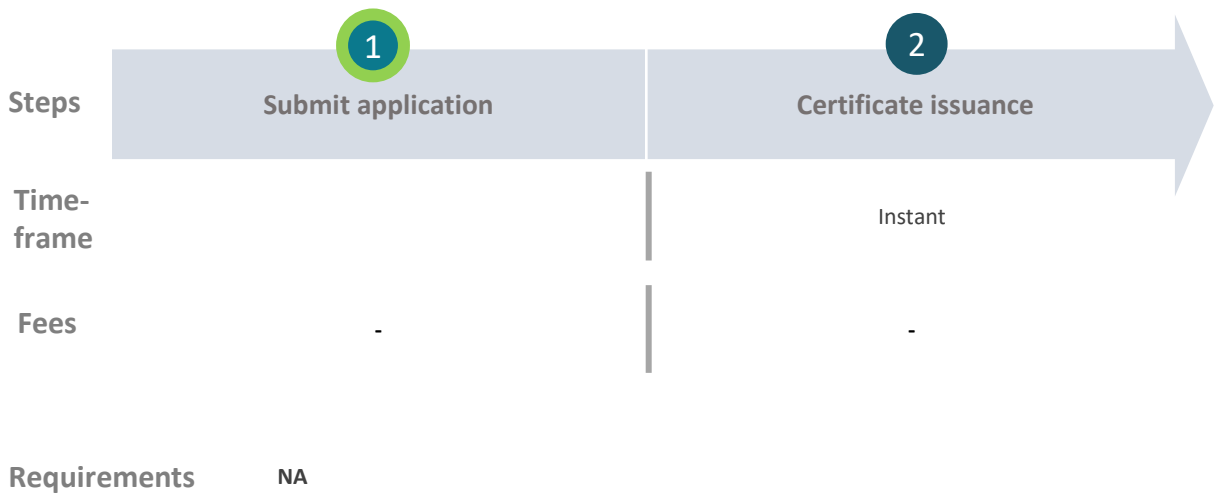

- The certificate can be sent through the system to other authorities, by stating their email in the application form





Accredit CME Provider

Through this service, DOH licensed healthcare facility or Training Facility (licensed by Abu Dhabi Department of Economic Development) are able to become a CME courses provider in the emirate of Abu Dhabi.

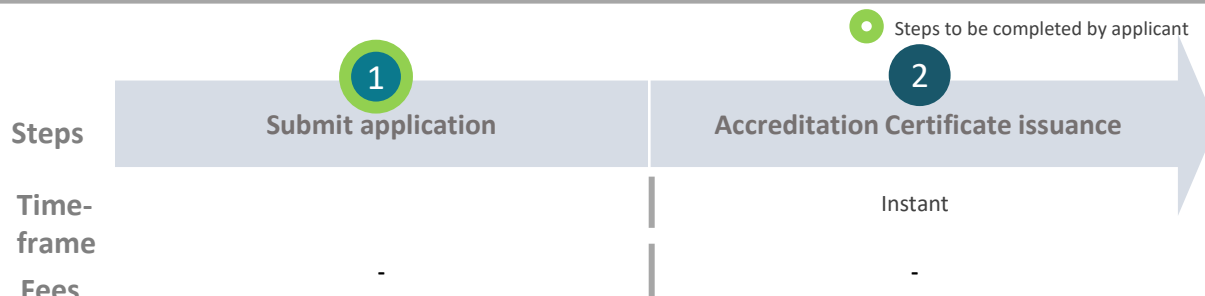

- If the above criteria does not apply on the government entities or association that provide medical education, the provider must contact cmesection@doh.gov.ae with the agenda and medical education objectives for requesting to obtain a CME provider access – subject for internal review & approval
- To start providing CME courses, each course (program) must be accredit by DOH first - [Link](#)
- Accreditation Certificate is validity is linked to the Health facility/ training facility validity. For government entities/ association, the certificate is valid for 2 years
- There is no minimum requirements of staff count in the facility to request for the service





Amend CME Provider Accreditation

Through this service, DOH accredited CME providers are able to change the in-charge academic coordinator or update their contact details, renew or cancel the facility accreditation as a provider.

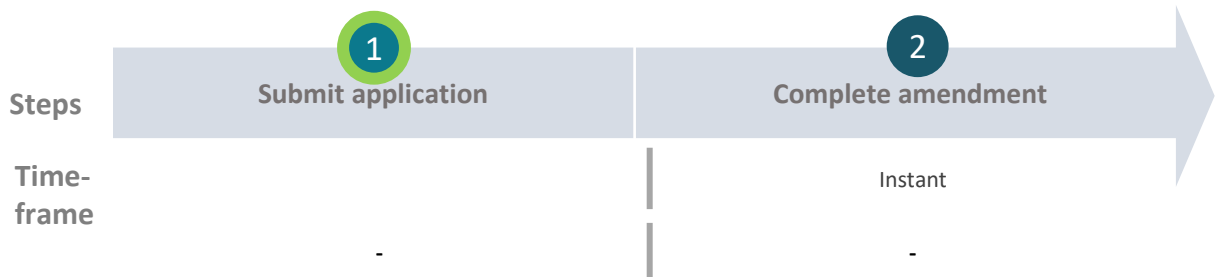

Accredit CME Program

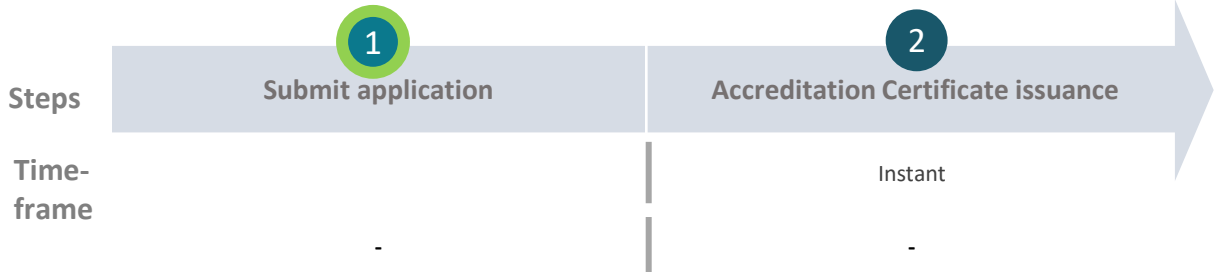

2. Fill the Commercial support declaration available within the application form (if the event is sponsored)

Limitation

- CME activity specification:
 - Maximum 7.5 CME per day
 - Must be no less than 60 minutes in duration (can be divided into two sessions, 30 minutes each)
- Cannot request approval for a CME activity on the same day of applying

Notes

- No limitation for number of attendees for each CME activity
- DOH accredit CME programs that take place in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi Only
- CME courses does not give license privileges, the CME program/title must not include any misleading terminology example practice training, hands on training, master, diploma, fellowship etc.
- Advertising of the sponsor's specific products on written materials associated with the activity is not permitted.





Amend CME Program Accreditation

Through this service, DOH accredited CME providers are able to change dates & timing of approved CME courses (programs) or request canceling the course.

1. General

1.1. Can documents in languages other than English or Arabic be accepted for licensure/ participating in training?

Document in languages other than English or Arabic must be provided along with legal translation

1.2. Is attestation/ authentication needed for any of the requirement documents for licensure / participating in training?

Attestation/ authentication is not needed for any of the required documents. The Primary Source Verification process suffice this requirement

2. Licensing

2.1. How to know if my qualification is recognized in UAE?

- List of accredited graduates and postgraduate qualifications obtained from a UAE can be found [here](#)
- Hand-on courses obtained from UAE are considered accredited if recognized by one of UAE health authorities
- International qualifications/ courses are must be issued by institutions/colleges recognized by respected Authorities that recognize/accredit educational programs in that country

2.2. How to transfer MOHAP or DHA license to a DOH license?

Professionals with valid (or cancelled or expired within the past 6 months) MOHAP & DHA licenses need to apply for the DOH license through TAMM portal as detailed in the [Register New Professional License](#) service card.

- Re-evaluation of the healthcare professionals shall apply based on the [PQR](#) version applicable at the time of applying for the DOH license
- MOHAP / DHA license, valid GSC & recent experience must be verified (Only PSV reports addressed to DOH can be accepted. Thus, must apply for report re-issuance (transfer) for those reports and add to them the mentioned additional document)
- Exam exemption will apply based on MOHAP/ DHA license status and granted title

2.3. Are PSV reports addressed to other authorities (within UAE or outside UAE) accepted by DOH?

DOH will only accept PSV reports addressed to DOH. If the applicant already has a report which is addressed to another authority, they need to apply for report re-issuance (transfer) in order for the report to be addressed to DOH.

Note: Adding further document is possible when applying for report re-issuance.

2.4. How to request a DOH license/ GSC when opting to be licensed by other overseas health authorities?

Healthcare professionals or the overseas regulatory authority may contact us directly on hplicesning@doh.gov.ae requesting for the license and/ or GSC to be verified.

Note: DOH license number must be included in the email and a [DOH GSC](#) must be requested within 3 months from sending the verification request.

- Professionals with DHA or MOHAP valid licenses (or expired / cancelled within last 6 months) for the same title and are in Good Standing
- Previously licensed by DOH for the same title that is cancelled within the past 5 years
- Passed DOH assessment for the same title within the past 5 years

4. Medical Education (Training)

4.1. In case of Gap in clinical practice, where can the healthcare professional obtain the required training?

- **Outside UAE:** From complete an accredited training facility by the Regulatory Authority at that country (with the required license – if applicable)
- **DOH:** From an approved training facility. Communicate with CMEsection@doh.gov.ae for a list of those APS facilities.
- **Other emirates in UAE:** From an approved training facility as per the regulation of the health authority (MOHAP or DHA)

4.2. What should be done after completion of the required training?

- If the training is part of the required experience for UAE fresh graduate, then you may apply directly for a new license [service details](#)
- If the training was a part of the Gap of Practice requirements, then you have to share the completion letter along with the required CME certificates with CMEsection@doh.gov.ae to obtain a the Gap of Practice Completion Certificate, which can be later uploaded within the license request application

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH)

The Department of Health (DOH) is the regulatory body of the Health System in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi. It aspires excellence in Health for the community by regulating and monitoring the health status of the population. DOH defines the strategy for the health system, monitors and analyses the health status of the population and performance of the system. In addition, DOH shapes the regulatory framework for the health system, inspects against regulations, enforces regulations, and encourages the adoption of best practices and targeted performance expected by all health service providers. DOH also drives programs to increase awareness and adoption of healthy living standards among the residents of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in addition to regulating scope of services, premiums, and reimbursement rates of the health system in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

The Health System of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi encompasses the spectrum of health services and is accessible to all residents of Abu Dhabi through its integrated logistics network of health providers, professionals, patients, Insurers, academics, accreditors, and the regulators. Providers of health services include public and private sector services, and the system is financed through mandatory health insurance association to residents, in accordance with the applied regulations.

PREAMBLE

Health Regulations comprising of Policies, Standards and Circulars, collectively translate federal UAE and Abu Dhabi Laws into detailed practical set of tools to help drive compliance and improve access, quality, and transparency in the processes for leniency and consistency in the provided services.

On that account, this document is a comprehensive operational referencing document applied in licensing healthcare workforce, licensing teaching facilities/institutions and medical educational programs in alignment with the current standards. The DoH “Policy Manual” that was published in 2012 intrudes legislation, and general regulatory aspects, whereas the PQR translates the foundational licensing requirements primitively. This manual (Licensing Procedural Manual) incorporates substantial principles in licensing derived from legislations and regulatory frameworks aforementioned. It was drafted in collaboration with SME’s, other health regulators to further elucidate the processes, as the credentialing process may be





complicated by the wide range of diversified academic backgrounds and various credential case scenarios of applications, this document may address instances where related circumstances might arise.

This manual has taken its extensive lengthy time to benchmark, study situation statuses, analysis of the explicit Emirate healthcare development needs, substantially the vast majority of rules are implemented using actual case studies and historical scenarios taken from the preserved records. Moreover, based on Abu Dhabi cultural needs, we have finally shed consideration for the new relevant regulations compatible to the updated regulatory standards and resolutions. This document is, however, not a reference for salary scales or administrative positioning of individuals or professionals. More importantly, licensing professionals are referenced to professional skillset and competency assessed levels that designate eligibility of granted titles, that Health Providers are to adhere in privileging clinical and professional practice within the defined scope of practice and in accordance with the academic training and background experiences that assure safe practices are maintained. To upskill professionals in clinical knowledge and healthcare practice, medical educational settings and facilities that are recognized as training institutions by DoH must designate trainers who are experts, with the highest competency in mastering in their specialties. Prior to beginning training programs, trainees must obtain formal registrations from DoH, in all defined levels of training< as clarified in within this manual.

Introduction

Department of Health applies precise regulatory tools that best serve the interests of patient care, safety, community wellbeing and investor missions, this manual was created with a transparency approach to clarify the operational techniques used for openness and lucidity of the applied processes; to uphold and reinforce the licensing process and its operating procedures in compliance with best practices for uniformity, righteousness, and enlightening the applied principles to our invaluable stakeholders.

Purpose of this manual

This document explains the operating procedures when credentialing and reviewing applications submitted by Healthcare professionals, Healthcare Providers, Medical Education providers, Human Resources of Healthcare facilities, typing agencies or other, for the purposes of granting approvals or licenses for either, professional, interns, trainees, Medical Education training program delivery, professional licenses, medical educational institution, medical educational program providers or other similar approvals in accordance to the guidelines and criteria set by the Department of Health.

To outline the vision, policy goals, and governance requirements that provide the basis for Healthcare Professional license.

Ensure systematic applicable rules are in consistency in licensing and when granting approvals on similar scenarios.

To ensure transparency of the regulatory decrees comprehensive and are in implementation with drawing missing orders between regulatory traits or statements in published legislations.

To hold applicants (individuals) accountable, to adhere to the detailed requirements; as well as the implemented processes for efficient performance reviews, identifying compliance, and resolving any non-compliances.





Scope

Organizations, recruiters, health service providers, who are engaged in applying for approvals, or the privileged requests, licensing, and credentialing processes play an essential part in the applied operational procedures. Reviewers, applicants, credentialing committees, and regulatory agencies in charge of supervision are a few examples of this. Referencing the corresponding scopes of operational services. This manual outlines the range of services offered to the different healthcare markets by the departments listed below.

1. Credentialing and Licensing
2. Examination
3. Medical Education

Credentialing and Licensing

The process of credentialing involves a thorough examination and assessment of academic credentials, as well as knowledge, abilities, and competencies that show the conditional prerequisite licensing eligibility for safe and appropriate practice.

These are substantiated with assuring procedures like primary source verifications and validation of the acquired qualifications, primarily assessing professionals' competencies and capabilities to perform their profession safely prior to licensing. The licensing process aims to ensure that health professionals meet the DoH established standards and criteria.

Relatively, the crucial purpose of minimum set of requirements is to ensure safe practice is sound, the requirements include educational and academic background, passing licensure examinations, records of assuring safe practice, fulfilled the required practical training and/or experiential, and fulfilling continuing medical education requirements. Licensing health professionals serves vital goals, including:

- a) Public protection: Licensing ensures that individuals seeking healthcare services are treated by qualified professionals who have met the necessary standards of competence and ethics.
- b) Quality assurance: Licensing promotes quality in healthcare delivery by establishing minimum competency requirements and regulating professionals' ongoing performance and professional development, including upskilling and reskilling programs.
- c) Healthcare provider accountability: The role of Healthcare Providers remains crucial due to their unmediated association between the operational clinical practice and the designated roles of maintaining the safest and highest level possible of healthcare to the community of Abu Dhabi, by ensuring adherence to the applied policies, standards of practice, ethics, and conduct.
- d) Professional accountability: Licensing imposes a level of accountability on health professionals, to adhere to applied policies, standards of practice, ethics, and professional conduct.





e) Regulatory oversight: Licensing allows regulatory bodies or licensing authorities to monitor and enforce professional standards and maintain professional discipline refraining from any violations, negligence, malpractice, or misconduct.

It is evident in licensing based on numerous credentialing historical cases, where differences between academic and educational programs, with distinct curricula in most academic institutions, even for similar majors. Eventually, reviewal procedures may require stretched efforts in decision making on particular cases, and due to the variation academic institutions and the applied standards or curricula in similar specialties and professions. Moreover, country policies dissimilarities, political situations, and national laws worldwide have huge impacts in the standard levels. DoH's unique applicable standards and requirements may also differ in its processes, considering real-time risk analysis, regulatory jurisdictions, and healthcare professions as per the PQR. It is crucial for health professionals to complete the requirements for license renewal, which usually involve adhering to DoH ethical norms and continuing professional development.

Important notes listed below are to be considerate of when applying for licensure in Ab Dhabi.

- a) Professionals should seek employers to be licensed under the licensed Healthcare Facilities
- b) Healthcare Facilities must have the healthcare services of the professional
- c) Professionals must meet the licensure criteria and the applied policies and procedures. Must have acquired the recognized qualifications per the defined standards.
- d) Academic Qualifications/curriculums and length of study/credits must meet the standards.
- e) Professionals must have acquired the licensed experience requirements.
- f) Professionals must be in current good conduct prior to licensing, length of employment defined in the PQR must be in good professional conduct prior to licensing.
- g) Professionals may require fulfilling DoH assessment requirements, within the limited attempts only.
- h) Professionals must have genuine and correct credentials and certifications when submitting to DoH for licensing purposes.

Healthcare Provider's specify the ascertain Healthcare activities and their specialties they are capable to deliver to the patients of Abu Dhabi. Hence the recruiting and selection of the most competent professionals are under the discretion of the Health Provider. This discretion includes the correct selection the Professionals' Category, Major and Profession, based on the acquired qualifications and experiences attained by the potential professions who will be in the process of licensing, with reference to the PQR criteria. Moreover, encouraging trained health professionals to practice safely by granting licenses and granting privileges will help to control professional practice while protecting patients' rights through applying best practices. Professionals with valid licenses and granted professional titles must adhere to the licensed title scope of practice to preserve their practices.





Qualifications, Certifications & Training Courses.

There are scenarios, few scenarios listed below illustrate how we apply the rules to such unique cases, where there is careful review and in multiple levels prior to final decision making. Essential licensing requirements through sequential processes and priorities

This is because academic programs vary widely and so do the subjects taught or the training milestones in the hundreds of academic institutions worldwide.

The structure of qualifications should be continuous academic programs within the same specialty milestones and curriculums. The tenure of academic programs is well defined in the PQR, thus obstructed courses from unrelated major/profession ingrained in the profession/specialty program, shall be reviewed with deduction of the unrelated milestones. Theoretical and practical academic milestones in each program should meet the defined length of programs in the PQR to be at least 85%. Accreditation of the academic programs and educational programs are essential. Nonetheless, two separate academic programs (e.g., undergraduate diploma, then bridged to a bachelor's degree) within same major/specialty shall be endorsed providing that gap between the 2 programs is filled with related experience.

Note the length of academic program minimum duration standards accepted shown below;

Training Type	Medical/surgical	Dental	AHP/Nurses
Residency	Medical - 3 years and above Surgical - 4 to 7 years	2 years and above	2 years

A bachelor's degree in medicine or surgery must be earned in no less than 5 years without counting clinical rotations or internships, unless the DoH approves of a curriculum with a higher structure. Nonetheless, those whose internship programs did not meet the requirements; 4 years' experience post the recognized qualifications shall alternate.

General Practitioners shall require a full year academic internship program, within the 5 core rotations listed below for 4 blocks minimum training in the listed specialties below, with additional internship rotations in other elective specialties.

- Internal medicine
- General surgery
- Emergency Medicine
- Obstetrics & gynecology or Family Medicine
- Pediatrics





Internship programs requirements for General practitioners and General Dentists are considerable and endorsed only when they were conducted post final examination of the Bachelor's degree in medicine, apart from UAE academic institution graduates from either Khalifa University or MBRU graduates

Simultaneously, General Dentist bachelor's degree should not be less than 2 years program excluding the internship requirements.

Examination date on qualifications is considered the conferred date, to stretch the eligibility period of experiences, with providing of the final recognized qualification.

Physicians with postgraduate recognized qualifications are required to produce documentation of their clinical residency programs, transcripts, or other thorough training in a specialty that includes the start and finish dates of the training, with reference to the PQR issued in 2022. In an authorized academic training institution, the minimum allowable training duration within the specialty shall not be less than three years.

Detailed Residency programs and transcripts must be submitted for review, regardless of the Tier classification of the qualification, the start date and completion date of training are essential for credentialing review procedures.

Residency programs or academic programs that are obtained through more than one program in a similar specialty (both accredited in singular classification) within the same continuum years, (minimum) 2 years gap between the two programs (not overlapped), shall be endorsed if the total tenure of training programs were not less than 3 years, or equivalent to the specified length of study in the PQR.

When highest Qualifications are the licensing requirements, the pre-requisites acquired qualifications should be submitted along with the mandated qualifications, to allow appropriate credentialing and review procedures to take place.

Professionals who were licensed by DoH as GPs & GDs because they lack the complete required experience post their recognized specialty qualification, may complete the required experience in the providing the following:

The experience is practiced in an APS "A" or "I" facility, with multidisciplinary health specialty services.

The experience is supervised by a full-time consultant/ specialist of the same specialty or the superintendent of the facility.

Final recommendation letter/s of the superintendent/supervisor on the professional's competencies and skills is issued and shared with DoH when applying to change the professional's license title.

Residency programs for PGME specialties accepted are minimum 3 years regardless of the classification of the recognized qualification.

When a main specialty qualification is obtained from non-recognized qualifications in the PQR, but a physician has in addition obtained a recognized qualification in the related sub-specialty, and has acquired the minimum experience required for the sub-specialty, then the physician can be licensed in the sub-





specialty (practiced profession), providing that the main specialty tenure of program was NLT 3 years), such cases shall not go through the endorsements of exams whatsoever.

Post graduate Qualifications as required for AHP or Nurse professionals, that are direct entry, shall not be less than 5 years, e.g. Masters in physiotherapy of 5 years study duration shall be considered as a direct entry program, thus shall be accepted as equivalent to the Bachelor's and Master's combined.

Dual major qualifications/certificates for all categories maybe accepted when a single specialty tenure of the academic training is satisfactory or relevant period of study in the specialty is equivalent to the defined study duration in the PQR, in such a case, the relevant licensing title shall be based on the specialty of experience acquired.

UAE born professionals willing to be licensed and provide proof of having completed their High school in UAE but travelled to study in the countries listed in Tier 1 or 2, shall be considered as UAE graduates, thus, no experience shall be applied on them.

Study programs can only be accepted if proof of full-time in campus conducted. Blended learning studies may be reviewed, where when hands on practice courses, proving the theoretical curriculum length of study was in campus and is equivalent to the PQR defined length of studies or at least by 85%, and in such a case the licensing division director shall overwrite the decision with justifications of the decision.

Proof of full-time attendance on campus is a requirement for study programs to be approved. In blended learning studies, the director of the licensing division will have to override the decision and provide justifications if the hands-on practice courses demonstrate that the theoretical curriculum length of study was completed on campus and is at least 85% equivalent to the PQR defined length of studies.

Post-Basic Bachelor qualification programs (PGME) for AHP or Nurse professions must be of minimum 2 years apart from the listed countries who's possible PGME programs are one year that are endorsed, for more details refer to the PQR 2022, page 74, 17.1.6.

Undergraduate and postgraduate programs in any of the below majors, regardless of which supersedes the other, will be approved for clinical psychological licensing titles when corresponding curricula in the undergraduate majors/professions below are included, **providing the experience requirements in the specialty are met.**

If the psychology majors and curricula mentioned in the paragraph above were the undergraduate programs for the applying professionals, and the corresponding qualifications in the postgrad programs attained are as specified below can also be endorsed for licensing titles as per the applicable titles shown in the table below:

Relative qualifications in the listed specialties below if attained whether undergrad or postgrad, shall be accepted if the tenure of the academic programs collectively summed up of NLT 3 years, where the determined licensing title shall be of the acquired area/specialty experience. Equivalent programs and level of professional titles shall be applied accordingly.

Applicant with Radiotherapy technology undergrad qualification who also obtained a postgrad qualification in Medical Physicist can be endorsed for licensing when the collective tenure of educational programs were NLT 5 years, however the determined licensing title shall be of the acquired area/specialty experience.

Experience

Case scenarios below demonstrate how we apply the processes to them to help provide clear guidance and ensure consistency in decision-making. Taking note of the variations in healthcare services, facility capacity, national nature, and regulatory standards that could impact the practice's uniqueness.

Reference to PQR issued in 2022, experience when required for a tenure defined, they are only accepted post the specialty post-grad qualification, in clinical settings, and to be within the profession of the potential professional willing to be licensed.





Professionals willing to be licensed must submit legal permit to practice per the country Health authority regulatory rules, issued by the authorized organization or authority, the experiences submitted shall all be within the validity of the practiced experience.

Professionals willing to be licensed as specialists in their corresponding specialties and have obtained the recognized qualifications, but were licensed as General Practitioners for not having sufficient experiences, DoH shall only endorse the experiences acquired in Abu Dhabi, if they were practiced in a department of the same specialty with at least 3 interrelated disciplines, and have worked under supervision of a superintendent, with submitting a release letter stating the competency level and safety status to be granted with a higher title.

Professionals willing to be licensed or relicensed by DoH, do not require to submit licenses/registrations that match DoH CMP, however the licenses/registrations should be active in the period of practice, this also means that the licenses do not need to be active when applying to DoH, unless they are required in the PQR to endorse a component or so.





Membership registrations that are required in the PQR for AHP and Nurse titles, however the professional willing to be licensed obtained it post the experiences, shall still be accepted, e.g. CSS technicians, Electro-Neurodiagnostic Technologists; experience before obtaining the registration/ membership can be accepted

Non-licensed experiences with proof of licensed experience at a later period from same Authority of country practiced within same state/country, in such cases all experience post the recognized qualification regardless issued date of the license shall be endorsed.

Non-direct professions to patients, that as per the health regulatory rules in the country of practice, do not license such professionals, DoH shall not mandate nor request the license to practice, this is applicable to AHP only.

The required experience for the title shall be post the date of obtaining the recognized/ required qualification, with pre-license issuance as applicable.

The required experience for the requested title shall be covered by a valid license/ registration (where applicable) and a valid GSC. However, unlicensed experience from government health facilities (inside or outside UAE) can be accepted, with proof of “current license status” from the regulatory authorities, indicating that the previous unlicensed experiences were endorsed by the corresponding regulator. In case a license for such cases was issued at a later stage, previous experience shall be endorsed.

There are interrelated experiences within defined scope of practice in some categories that shall be endorsed such as:

A consultant or specialist physician with the main specialty recognized qualification and does not have the sub-specialty qualification nor training, but has had at least 5 years’ experience in the sub-specialty, he/she shall be assessed in both main and sub-specialty to be granted with the privileges in the sub-specialty (provided the hiring facility has the corresponding specialty). Similar scenario applies to specialists

A consultant or specialist physician with specialty recognized qualification in a sub-specialty profession (direct academic training to the sub-specialty due to the PGME system of country trained) but has had at least 5 years’ experience in the sub-specialty, he/she shall be assessed in both main and sub-specialty to be granted with the licensing title in the sub-specialty (provided the hiring facility has the corresponding specialty), however such scenarios shall be classified as Tier 3.

A qualified registered nurse for licensing, has practiced in either of the nurse disciplines or nurse specialties, however he/she shall be assessed in the discipline of the specialty to be granted with the privileges in the specialty area (conditionally that the hiring facility should have the corresponding specialty services)





Nurse and AHP experience cognately interluded shall be endorsement as per the examples illustrated below;

Similarly, scenarios of qualifications with curriculums that are interrelated to the defined SOP, may allow licensing processes to endorse those qualification to the experiences providing that the qualification requirements are equivalent by academic level or higher to the potential title to practice per the definition of the PQR.

Moreover, specialty nurse privileges can be granted to nurses who've have acquired 4 years minimum experience in the specialty areas.

Furthermore, applicants should fulfill the length of experience requirements per the PQR on the requesting titles, with considerations to the scope of practice interrelated to the professions in the requesting titles.

DoH historical records of professionals are maintained and referenced accordingly, therefore those previously granted with evaluations issued by DoH, may be re-granted with same professional title, as long as experiences were within same specialty till recent year, moreover exams shall be applied if 5 years have exceeded from leaving DoH system.

Overlapped experiences must be singularized and cannot be counted more than once during the same practice time.





Professionals whose criteria require a Post-graduate qualification, and are UAE graduates shall not require 6 months training for licensure.

In scenarios where symmetrical credentials were considered, DoH shall mandate the examinations on applicants to assess the competency levels and their potential professional practice (licensing title) capabilities for safe practice, regardless of their exam certificate attainment or exam equivalency criteria, on the contrary if those whose SOP are indifferent shall not require examination.





Gap of Practice

Professionals with Gap of Practice must apply in the e-licensing system for the license providing their required documents to obtain an official gap of practice requirements feedback (training period & CME), moreover, they shall be issued with registration form for formal recognition as trainees in the designated teaching facilities (APS A and APS I)

The professional must join an approved APS facility to cover the gap within 2 months before entering the next category of GOP (delay in enrolling may require re-calculation of the GOP), example case scenario below to clarify the procedures further.

Last day of clinical work was 12/12/2020.

Applied for the license on 28/3/2024.

Gap of practice duration is more than three (3) years less than four (4) years.

Professionals is required to join a training facility before 12/12/2024 to avoid recalculation of GOP, as shown below.

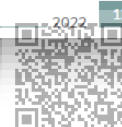
1.6 Exam Equivalency Criteria

- 1.6.1 Healthcare professionals who successfully completed certain international examinations and/or hold an active registration/license to practice by certain regulatory bodies will be exempted from the licensure examination (refer to Exam Equivalency Criteria chapter) post fulfilling the applied title requirements.
- 1.6.2 In the case of examination exemption, the scope of the exemption is limited to exam requirements. It does not apply to any other requirements for licensure such as credentialing, experience, PSV, etc.

1.7 Discontinuity of Practice (Gap of Practice)

- 1.7.1 Healthcare professionals who have an interruption of clinical practice exceeding **two (2) years** and opting to be licensed in the UAE must follow the CME/CPD requirements below; this includes healthcare professionals providing telehealth services.
- 1.7.2 All CME/CPD credits must be related to the practice specialty of the healthcare professional and according to the CME/CPD specific requirements of the Authorities.
- 1.7.3 All applicants are required to complete a clinical training program accredited by Regulatory Authority in the specialty field.
- 1.7.4 All clinical training programs shall be carried out in APS health facility recognized by the Authorities.
- 1.7.5 All applicants (apart from UAE nationals and Children of Emirati Women) are required to pass the Authorities licensure examination after the completion of CME/CPD credits and clinical training programs within the related profession. This includes Healthcare professionals with valid Exam Equivalency proof according to the Exam Equivalency Criteria chapter and have completed the Gap of Practice requirements.
- 1.7.6 In general, Non-UAE Nationals will not be able to apply for a license if they have a gap of practice for more than **five (5) years** (and more than **ten (10) years** for UAE nationals and Children of Emirati Women).
- 1.7.7 UAE nationals who have an interruption of clinical practice due to the UAE mandatory National services are not considered in Gap of Practice.

Post completing the gap of practice requirements, the healthcare professional must apply for the license within one year from the issued date of the GOP certificate by DoH to prevent entering a new cycle of gap of practice.

Professionals with interruptions in their surgical practice (insufficient operations or very limited number was performed or practiced in an area of the SOP, in the last (2) years) the following shall apply:

Limitation to practice safely within their recent 2 years fields/areas.

Surgeons can reinstate their full privileges once GOP requirements are fulfilled in their professional SOP, through a supervised surgical training conducted under a consultant physician within the same specialty.

Exams and Exam equivalency

Even though a professional may have the recognized qualifications, however DoH may require to evaluate their competencies and skills by requesting additional exams or internationally recognized exams.

Exam mandates are applicable and reviewable only when credentialing and review processes are successfully met, thus determination on whether exams are required or not, come after surpassing the steps.

Exams will be conducted with reference to the PQR issued in 2022, license endorsement from the Health Regulatory Authorities of the United Arab Emirates, which remains endorsable when the PQR criteria are met, and evidence that their licenses are in good standing without prior license impairments, unless a component has partially met the requirements and with a valid licensing reason granted by the division director of licensing.

Healthcare professional who holds valid license from the Health Regulatory Authorities of UAE, either MOHAP, SHA or DHA, with a higher professional title, and meets a lower title or requesting a lower title, shall not require sitting DoH exam, if the license and CGS from these regulatory authorities are valid (3 months form issued date). Nonetheless, DoH may categorize professions to sit the DoH exams regardless if they meet the endorsement criteria or fulfill the exam equivalency criteria, upon patient care risk analysis.

Healthcare professional who holds valid license from the Health Regulatory Authorities of UAE, either MOHAP, SHA or DHA, with a lower professional title, and meets a higher title or requesting a higher title, shall require sitting DoH exam, if the license and CGS from these regulatory authorities are valid.

Professionals with the recognized qualifications from either of the listed countries, Austria, Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Ireland, Netherland, New Zealand, South Africa, Sweden, United Kingdom, and United States of America, and submit proof of being in current good conduct, and have met the experience requirements reference to the PQR 2022 criteria, shall not require assessments, unless in a case where a component have partially met the requirements, and with a justifiable reason of licensing taken by the division director of licensing, shall proceed with exams.





The cancellation or failure to attend the booked examination will not be considered as a failed attempt, however a professional shall be mandated to restart the credentialing steps, where GOP may apply.

Professionals whose licenses have been impaired or sanctioned in the recent 5 years shall not be included in the exam exemption criteria or exam equivalency criteria regardless the experience acquired, or certifications attained.

DOH determines the exam type and mode, and any changes will be communicated via the licensing portal. Furthermore, depending on the professional's qualifications and profile review, DoH may choose to evaluate them for the appropriate exam type.

The announced result shall indicate a “pass” or “fail” without details of the result (e.g., attained score/percentage) of the assessment.

DOH examination pass result is valid for 5 years, however those whose professional practice may have been impaired may require re-sitting exams. Moreover, those whose practice have undergone interruptions or been in GOP, shall require sitting exams.

Upon failing the examination, the healthcare professional may apply for a second or third attempt with no restriction on duration between the attempts for 6 months from the approved date of examination.

In case of failing and exhausting the three exam (3) attempts; the applicant is granted three (3) new attempts post obtaining a new qualification, provided that the additional certificate/ qualification is recognized as per the PQR and verified as positive.

Physicians applying for a new license for a sub-specialty title directly (fulfilling the sub-specialty criteria) may attain the title after passing the DoH exams in the profession, notwithstanding those fulfilling endorsement criteria/exam equivalency shall not require sitting DoH exams however PQR criteria constructs the category level qualified. Conversely, sub-specialty academic training resulting in recognized Board certification shall be credentialed with consideration to that, unlike those whose specialties are considered rare and have acquired the academic training without the final board certification (perhaps due to inexistence of the board), such procedures are applied case by case basis.

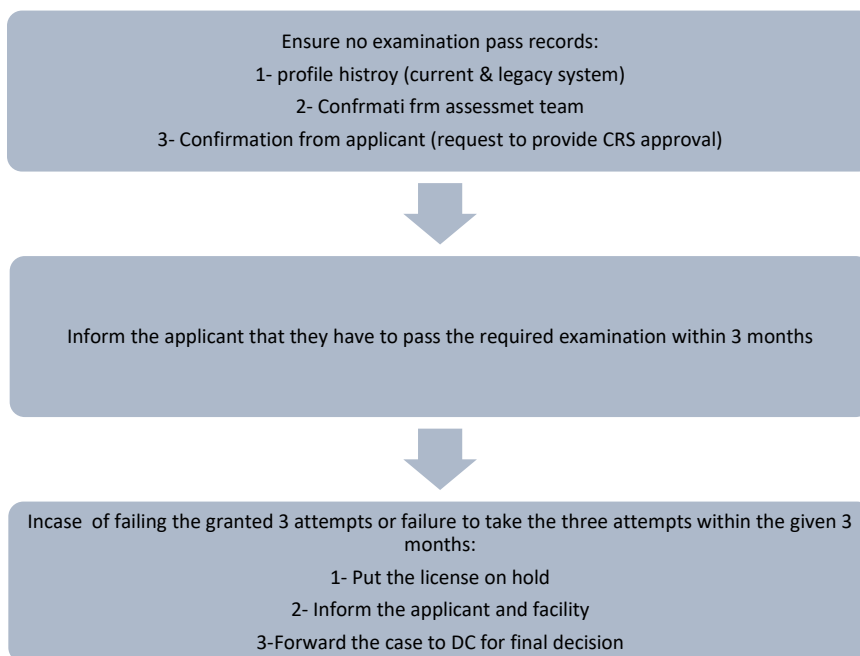
If a professional has more than five years of experience in their subspecialty and has obtained a recognized qualification in that field, but their main specialty qualification is not recognized, the Department of Health may accept their experiences and permit them to take the exam, even if they hold exam-equivalency or UAE Authority certifications.

Professionals willing to be licensed by DoH shall have to pass the required examinations, there are no exceptions whatsoever, furthermore, DoH may apply examinations on professionals whenever deemed necessary for patient's safety assurance





All sub-specialty title attainment are exam prerequisites prior to licenses, as no such certifications are exam equivalent.



Since none of these certifications are exam-equivalent, achieving all sub-specialty title attainments is a precondition for licensing.

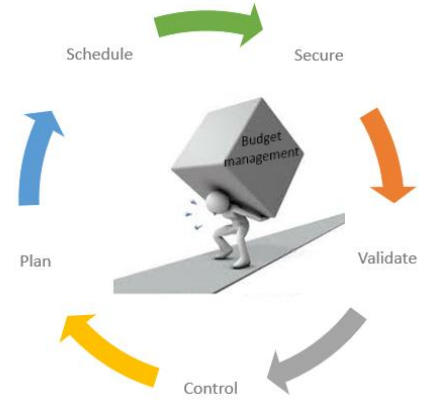
DOH examination exemption applies on the following:

- a) Healthcare professionals who passed DOH assessment for the same title or a lower title (e.g., RN and is applying for the title of AN, or consultant in a specialty to specialist in the same title) within 5 years from the date of applying.
- b) Healthcare professionals who have their DOH license cancelled within 5 years from the date of applying and are requesting the same title or a lower title (e.g., RN and is applying for the title of AN, or consultant in a specialty to specialist in the same title)
- c) Pass scores of 70% of the Emirates Residency Examination are endorsable by DoH, hence those who have attained these exams in their related professions shall not require sitting DoH exams, these exam results are considered valid for 5 years from their dates, as clarified below:
 - I. Those seeking licenses as general practitioners who have passed the Emirates Medical Residency Entry Exam (EMREE)
 - II. Those seeking licenses as general dentists who have passed the Emirates Dental Residency Entry Examination (EDREE)
 - III. Those seeking licenses as Pharmacists who have passed the Emirates Pharmacy Residency Entry Examination (EPREE)





- d) Professionals are granted 3 attempts across all regulatory authorities, however, a fourth attempt may be granted for assessments upon justifications contemplating to the PQR, where this fourth attempt is preferably to be assessed under DoH panelists.
- e) Any failure records of applicants in DoH examinations shall mandate DoH examination pass results in same specialty, regardless of exam equivalency certificates are obtained.
- f) A fourth attempt maybe permissible upon exam attempt reviews and valid justifiable statements are given by the Division Director



However, shown below are case scenarios that may be applicable in some credential cases.

- a. DoH may grant privileges to consultant and specialist physicians in sub-specialties based on the acquired further experiences within the sub-specialties of the main licensed title or based on the interrelated professional experiences attained beyond the defined SOP, however such privileges shall be assessed by DoH to ensure safe practice and capability measures are applied, upon a pass result, these privileges reflect on the professionals' licenses.
- a. Privileging within framework of professional scope of practice as defined by DoH, or per the academic training back-ground of professionals (e.g., ACGME, RCI accreditation and curriculums) is under the discretion of the internal operational committee of the healthcare facility/Medical Director or Dental Director, whomever is the clinical superintendent of the Healthcare facility, after internal assessments on the professionals' safe practice within the defined scope of practice.
- b. The Medical Director or the superintendent of the facility (internal operational committee) determines the privileges that a professional is capable to work safely within the defined SOP framework of the profession by either the DoH or based on the Medical Director or the superintendent privileging (privileging committee) to the professional following internal interviews and evaluation of the professional safe practice spectrum's skill sets and capabilities.
- c. Further to the above, DoH may limit or revoke a privilege or more when deemed necessary for patient safety, due to documentations and reviewing stages of licensing or re-licensing or other.
- d. DoH may restrict privileges within or beyond professionals' practice when insufficient experience within the scope of practice is detected.
- e. DoH may grant privileges to health professionals meeting licensure requirements, within interrelated scope of practice upon meeting the relevant training or experience.





- f. However, upskilling, or reskilling programs may be introduced in conjunction with DoH approval based on the critical need for healthcare services in a DoH-defined specialty or field. Additionally, DoH may determine the privileged period based on the curricula's academic milestones and the acquired competencies; these may be renewable when professionals retake additional academic programs.
- g. Since the defined scope falls inside the specialty, there are certain areas within the core of specialist privileging that do not require privileging by DoH when the SOP defines the licensed title. In such cases, neither licensing nor privilege will be necessary.
- h. Privileges granted are either permanent or temporary, permanent are academic course based, whereas temporary are short-course of at least 6 months and are invalidated bi-annual in case of new certifications were not acquired. The temporary privileges are renewable for the same period previously granted if proof of attending new courses post the previous privileges granted dates.
- i. DOH may limitation or grant privileges to a licensed professional, upon credentialing review (New, re-license or renew) depending on the qualification and practice of the healthcare professional. The examination shall be applied based on the given limitation/ privilege. Examples:
Physicians of surgical specialties with inadequate number of procedures, suggesting incapacity to practice, or insufficient exposure to surgical practice or with concentrated scope of operations/ procedures on one or several fields within the specialty
- j. Healthcare professionals with limited scope as per their studies (e.g., Qualification in fixed prosthodontics), shall be limited to practice within the trained competencies.
- k. Relative qualifications/certifications and related experience acquired should undergo PSV procedures prior to privileging and/or licensing processes.
- l. Exam procedures, as a part of crucial and requisites for licensing, assesses professionals' competencies, fitness, and skills prior to working in Abu Dhabi. Exam procedures are applicable to all applicants apart from those with certifications that are alleged to be equivalent to DoH exams, or as per the defined rules in the PQR.
- m. Any DoH exam failures shall not apply any documentations for endorsement, whether DHA or MOHAP or exam equivalency certificates.
- n. GOP policy may be applied on applicants licensing request, when there have been interruptions of professional practice or when discontinuity of the professional practice is encountered in the defined periods stipulated in the PQR. Nonetheless, the GOP determination is applied to individuals who, albeit having obtained the necessary experiences at a given time, ceased employment for a duration exceeding two years.





- o. GOP may be replaced with postgraduate academic studies (in a similar profession) that match the GOP's tenure if it is determined that there have been disruptions in experiences; in this scenario, no GOP requirements will apply, however the CME credits shall still be mandated for submission.

Requirements: *(refer to list of checklist in table below)*

Personal Identity information: Formal official identification as represented by official documents such as a passport or EID. Such information to be precisely utilized on data entry for license requests and other corresponding transactions.

Personal Identity is essentially used to identify the ownership of the certifications related to the professional applying for licensing transactions.

When the application is received by HPL officer (after payment on TAMM an auto-generated application number is issued), the applicant had voluntarily selected his profession, with which the credentialing procedures shall apply the rules and criteria accordingly. The credentialing team will carefully check that all qualifications presented are accurate and legitimate in relation to the applicant's identity. An intense review of academic transcripts or residency of the professional certifications, training certificates, and other relevant credentials proceed, and in case of any discrepancy or uncertainty, the credentialing team may reach out to the applicant for clarification or additional documentations.

Once qualification requirements are met, the credentialing officer will then review experience letters provided (if criteria mandate experiences), with relating license or registration issued by the regulatory authority in country where the applicant had practiced. The credentialing officer's duty is to ensure that the scope of practice and the acquired experience are sufficient computing to proceed with reviewing professional conduct status if he/she has been in good standing, once this requirement is checked, Primary source verification reports are reviewed as a final credentialing review point prior to proceeding to examination processes if applicable.

Application Submission by the license requester, the professional or the employer, and should ensure essential requirements stipulated in the PQR are met, to include the checklist below as numbered and specified, where the expected decision would depend on the credentialing and review outcome.

1. If the applicant is not eligible for the voluntary selected title, but is eligible for a lower title, the credentialing officer will recommend the change.
2. If the applicant is eligible for a higher title, the credentialing officer will review the application only based on the selected title with no further recommendations.





Further internal consultation processes on unusual licensure case scenarios:

Application will be assigned to the reviewers either the Director of licensing or to the internal credentialing panel with corresponding case details and related certificates.

The reviewer(s) may also conduct interviews, assessments, or site visits if required to gather additional information.

The reviewer(s) will document their findings, recommendations, and any concerns they may have during the review process.

The decision will be communicated to the applicant in writing, outlining the reasons for approval or rejection, apart from the unclear or indirect applications with credentials that do not precisely fit the criteria, will be referred to internal reviews and discussions, then final decision will be communicated to applicants, formally the communication means are through the e-application systems

The reviewer(s) will carefully evaluate the application against the established criteria and guidelines, to find positive results that satisfy patients interest utmost and applicants.

- a. DOH reserves the right to issue license types and titles beyond those listed in the PQR when deemed necessary and as per DOH related regulations and circulars. Examples:
 - i. Visiting physicians' licenses
 - ii. Temporary licenses
- b. DOH officers may give credentialing advises or recommendations through emails, however, official credentialing review through the licensing system allows comprehensive access to the application case, thus the system applied cases for licenses are accurate by far compared to manual reviews.
- c. Exceptional cases of license types may require approvals by the Division Director per the DOA

Below illustrates the essential components for licensing, with the related documents that are to be submitted for credentialing and review, however additional documents maybe required to clarify the standard levels of the credentials with the contexts within that should confirm the eligibility and safe practice prior to licensing, moreover the last column is applicable when the criteria mandate the PSV requirement. The requirements on the acquired qualifications and certifications for potential professionals willing to be licensed by DoH are essential to be uploaded in the e-profile from the submission time. However, professionals newly graduated whose PQR criteria do not require to have experiences per the PQR, do not need to verify any experiences obviously, on the contrary, professionals who do not require experiences per the PQR but have practiced in the recent 2 years or more shall have to submit their experience letters for verifications.

Professionals' Conduct status:

Professionals willing to be licensed should have clear records from back-ground criminal records, malpractice, unethical practice, or medical errors of any kind.

Potential professionals to be licensed by DoH, should be in current professional good conduct, per the maintained regulatory records by the designated health authorities of the country where practiced.

Good standing requirements on Professionals for licensing or re-licensing are evaluated for the duration of the experience required per the PQR; that is, if a profession requires ten years of experience to obtain a requested license title, applicant must be in good standing during that mentioned period; likewise, if a profession only requires two years of experience to obtain a requested license title, then the applicant must be in good standing during that period. However, background checks that verify professionals will still be applicable for any critical cases that may revert this rule

Professionals' current conduct records that are retrieved or made available online by their international regulatory bodies are both practically accepted and recommended.

To protect patients from the risks of medical errors, DoH maintains the right to refuse licensing any professionals whose records contain prior malpractice or complaints

Information in the certificate of professional conduct status is limited to the healthcare professional's medical practice and shall not include:

- Non-medical criminal/legal cases or ethical conduct
- Corrective Actions taken against the healthcare professional in the past ten (10) years from the date of requesting the certificate.

The healthcare professionals' request for licensure will be rejected and their name will be added to the Professional Prohibited list once it is discovered that they are not in good standing , or have not disclosed any breach, violations, or having had impairment license, or if a disciplinary action was taken against their license during their professional practice or other.

Whereas, in case of any malpractice conducted by a licensed professional, execution of the final committee decisions shall apply.

The Department of Health (DoH) will implement the final sanctionable decisions made by the UAE regulatory authorities for professionals. Additionally, professionals in the GCC countries will not be granted a license in such a status until they have been cleared and verified as being in good standing by their country of practice or regulatory authority.

DOH GSC shall be issued to HPs currently or previously licensed by DoH when requested. Professionals licensed by DoH do not need to submit the CGS issued by DoH, as these records are maintained within the e-profiles of the professionals.





Professionals without a DoH license who have an ongoing CRI will be placed on hold until their clear professional conduct is established, or until a medical liability letter or comparable document from an advocacy group that has been allowed demonstrates their lack of involvement in medical errors or malpractice.

Record-Keeping and Compliance:

- 23 The Health Professional Licensing Department will maintain detailed records of all credentialing and reviewing processes, including application forms, supporting documents, reviewer recommendations, and approval or rejected decisions.
- 24 Timeframe in licensing is roughly premediated as shown in the figure below, with dependencies on the interval in which the e-application is at;
- 25 Thus, submitting complete requirements, with clear readable copies, legal translated certifications, refrain from submitting unrelated and unnecessary documentations, prompt responding to requested requirements and following up with the progression of the applications electronically, minimize turnaround time of licensing.

Primary Source Verification

- a) PSV is currently delegated by DOH to a third-party professional verification agency to validate the required documents.
- b) Healthcare professionals opting to obtain a DOH license is obliged to verify the required documents for licensure as stated in the Unified Healthcare Professional Qualification Requirement (PQR); inclusive.
- c) Relative qualification/s to the profession of the requested title for licensing.
- d) Irrelative qualifications or additional qualifications are not required and should be disregarded.
- e) DOH may proceed with licensing certain categories/ professionals' titles without the final PSV report.
- f) PSV reports previously issued, and addressed to DoH, in the required component, shall not be re-verified, regardless if new specifications are applied post date of the PSV report.
- g) DoH reserves the right to reject any forgery PSV results, or tampering on documentations or any discrepant that may encounter...
- h) Residency program details/curriculum or transcripts or any academic program certifications are essential for credentialing purposes for either licensing or privileges and must undergo Primary Source Verification processes apart from those issued by the accredited programs in Austria, Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Ireland, Netherland, New Zealand, South Africa, Sweden, United Kingdom, and United States of America. Nonetheless, any of these listed countries having less than 3 years study duration must declare when applying for licensure.

PSV matrix guidelines for the licensing decision-making process

The Primary Source Verification results and findings on essential documents and certifications crucially needed for licensing procedures, thus we have clarified scenarios and licensing processes on them

Professionals willing to be licensed or re-licensed, yet the above matrix is a rejection, may revalidate their credentials through PSV recognized procedures.

- If an applicant's report had both the UTV component results and the discrepancy, each component would need to be addressed independently in accordance with the matrix.
- When a report for the same applicant is issued by distinct entities and contains a discrepant component and another correctly verified component, the licensing process shall be on hold till all components are PSV correctly.
- Positive reports with missing necessary information for licensure (such as the mode of study or unclear verification results) will result in the application being rejected until all necessary components are confirmed.
- If the DoH was notified that a professional, regardless of category, had inconsistent recent results with relation to other licensing bodies (within or outside the UAE), appropriate action in accordance with the above matrix would be taken.
- In the event of a final court decision in favor of the professional substantiating the alleged document (the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is required to include attestation when the document was issued outside of the United Arab Emirates), DoH shall endorse the document attested by the homeland government as correct.
- For healthcare professionals who have experience(s) within different countries/ authorities, only the GSC pertaining to the most recent experience is required to be verified. The rest of the GSCs must be attached within the licensure request.
- If the healthcare professional GSC is verified within the past 2 years, and he/ she are still practicing within the same country, there will be no need to verify the recent valid copy. However, it must be attached within the licensure request.
- DoH may endorse additional PSV reports on one or two certificates if they were addressed to another regulatory authority, if there is a main report addressed to DoH as well as components and standard of PSV are per DoH requirements.

Professionals may request multiple CMP/professional licensing titles, based on relevancy, eligibility and safety assurance in practice providing recognized qualification have been obtained and the required experience with the related license/ registration and GSC, however there shall be exam requirements, and there maybe cases that shall not be eligible based on the algorithms set forth and the business rules. However, each CMP request shall undergo a single application request.

Application auto-close processes in the steps below shall be automatically closed on KPI time elapses when no response forthcoming to the requirements.

Appeals Process:

- a. In case an application for license is rejected, the applicant may have the right to appeal the decision, through hplicensing@doh.gov.ae
- b. The appeals process may involve submitting additional information, attending hearings, or engaging in discussions with the credentialing panelists.
- c. The applicant will be informed of the final decision reached throughout the appeals procedure.

Licensing System control and rules applied.

- a) All DOH services for licensure, examination and medical education are provided electronically.
- b) DOH reserves the right to set the validity of each step within the provided services.
- c) Applicants get instant notifications via email and SMS with the progressions of their e-applications.
- d) To maintain the KPI's and to develop licensing services, each transactions/application is expected to have immediate response from applicants, however in case of prolong delays in response, transactions maybe closed assuming no interest in proceeding with the applications, in such cases professionals will have to apply again – no refund is applicable in this case.
- e) A refund of paid amount is only applicable in technical issues scenarios.
- f) Applications may be re-opened or moved to a prior step following for corrections purposes only.

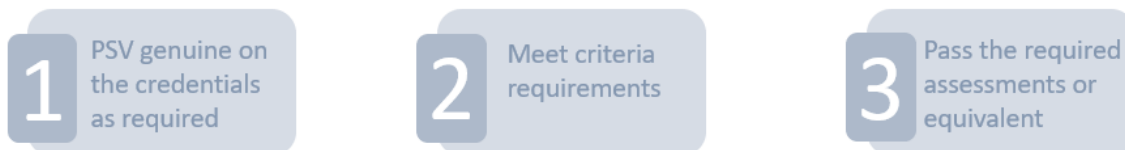

The main three licensing stages for permanent are as shown below. Whereas TP and VP shall require submitting and paying for PSV, then initial credentialing on step 2, and postpone step 3.



The purpose of governing license validity is to ensure healthcare providers and licensed professionals will inevitably apply safety, accountability, and compliance to standards, regulations, and license renewal requirements. To ensure compliance with governing license validity requirements and to keep records updated, it is essential to follow the below tips:

Keep track of the expiration dates of all licenses and permits required for your business.

- Ensure accurate and correct contact details of the professionals, PRO's and the superintendents are recorded in professionals' e-profiles, as notifications are sent to the provided contacts in the system.
- Pay attention to the auto-notifications sent to professionals or set up reminders or alerts to notify you when licenses are due for renewal.
- Maintain renewal requirements including CME accredited courses, in addition to organized documentation of all licenses and permits, including copies of the original documents.





- d. Stay informed about any changes in licensing regulations or requirements that may affect your business.

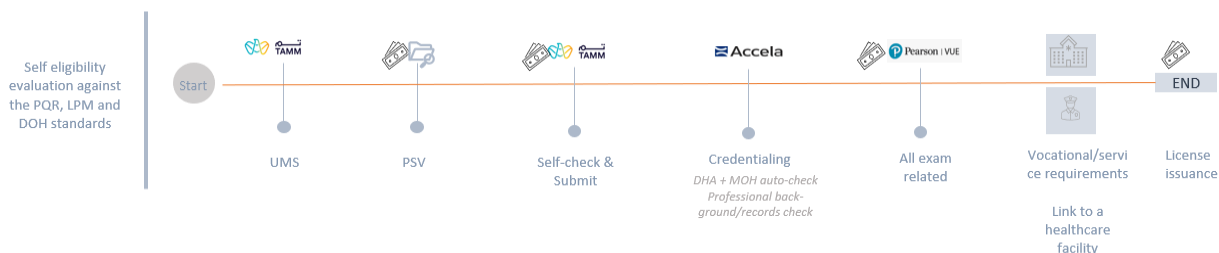
Plan-ahead and start the renewal process well before the expiration date to avoid any disruptions in operations, preferably a month prior to the expiration date.

Update your records promptly after renewing or obtaining new licenses to ensure accuracy in records are maintained.

Licensed Professionals by the Department of Health -Abu Dhabi

There are 2 categories of license status once granted/issued by DoH.

- 1.Active, which shall include below statuses, and in only such license status professionals are legally allowed to practice.
 - i. Current licensed (TP, VP and PL)
 - ii. About to expire license status
- 2.Inactive licenses, and in such license status professionals are illegal to practice.
 - iii. Suspended licenses
 - iv. Revoked licenses
 - v. Expired licenses
 - vi. Cancelled licenses
 - vii. License cancelled by law.
 - viii. License on hold
 - ix. Part time cancelled/cancellation

Add or change professional titles:

Based on SOP defined by DoH, inter-related specialties of main profession and sub-professions/specialties, or disciplines are either privileged by the Medical Directors or superintendents through the Medical/clinical committees in the facilities. However, such privileges are





conditioned on assurance on the professionals' capabilities in delivering clinical services in the additional specialties or privileging specialties.

Add or Change of title are applicable to DoH licensed professionals, new professionals shall have to undergo licensing procedures for the main profession of the professional's expertise as an entry to DoH registry.

Professions that are not directly interrelated to the specialties, or those that are advanced in same specialty that require additional competencies, must have accredited academic training programs to have DoH recognition and licensing or privileging processes through the formal electronic licensing system, for more information on the processes, refer to the attached "licensing service Catalogue".

A professional change or add, technical process permits one title at a time. This secures and structures the processes and electronic records, streamlining the procedures with allowing adequate requirement fulfillment inclusive the collective exam implementation processes.

Professional title change should be applied gradually per the categories and profession grading order per the hierarchy defined in the PQR i.e. GP cannot apply to be a consultant unless he has been a specialist prior to that.

Th purposes of licensing & privileging, conditions complete fulfillment of the PQR and licensing requirements, professionals primary/main category is the relevant profession of expertise of the professional, which no other category can be added to the license, however the professions can be added as privileges especially when the SOP are not interrelated, moreover, the additional title shall be the correspondent specialty or profession of practice, hence applicable procedures would be as described below:

Change Title:

- Scaling up the SOP within general or the same specialty within related category of the profession.
- Heightening of a specialty in a SOP with a focus area of practice.
- or a lower grade or upper grade of privileging due to competency-based capabilities upon assessments of either DoH and Employer/health provider or Medical Director or the superintendent
- Complete change of a profession

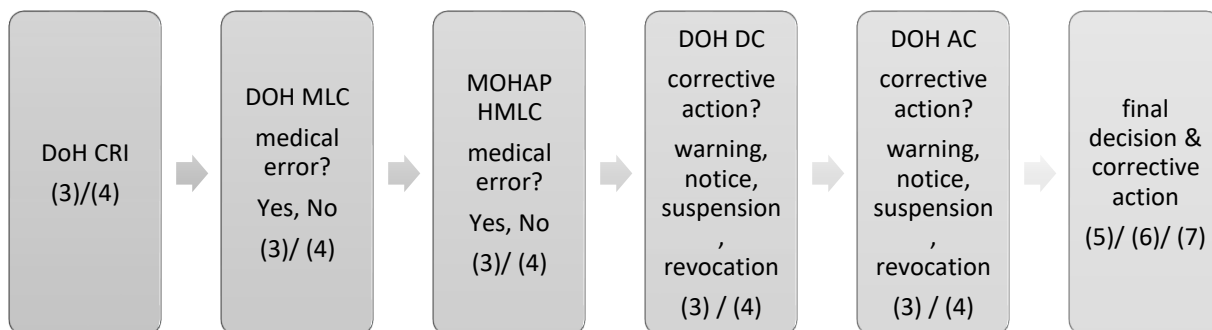

Professionals' Conduct statuses per DoH records and executions.

- i. In the event of authorized executions on professionals' licenses due to practice concerns or impairment, a professional's Certificate of Professional Conduct status may have impacts on them.
- ii. When a professional's license is revoked, the duration of the revocation becomes irreversible, unless a new decision by either a higher liability committee or court decision overrides that decision, and shall be formally communicated per the applied protocols, of DoH Legal Affairs or the appeal committee.
- iii. Workflow below illustrates issuance of professional certificate conduct status from the CRI procedures to final executed processes, reflected numbers to the table below are the contexts within the certificates of professional conduct in accordance to their stage of committee review and decisions.

Medical Education

The three medical education predominant elements listed below strategize the continuous supply of homegrown healthcare workforce to the Emirate and the country. With the stakeholder and partnership contributions and efforts, DoH sets the standards for the Medical Education elements, conducted through procedures including institutions assessments against the standards developed; eventually healthcare facilities with the suitable accreditation levels are granted with the accreditation to be teaching settings. Consequently, the trainees get the opportunities to benefit from these programs through academic training programs that are DoH accredited as well, and as a result the supply of homegrown workforce is effectuated in the Emirate.

- 1) Medical Education Institutions/Facilities
- 2) Medical Education Programs
- 3) Medical Education Participants

Medical Education Institutions/Facilities

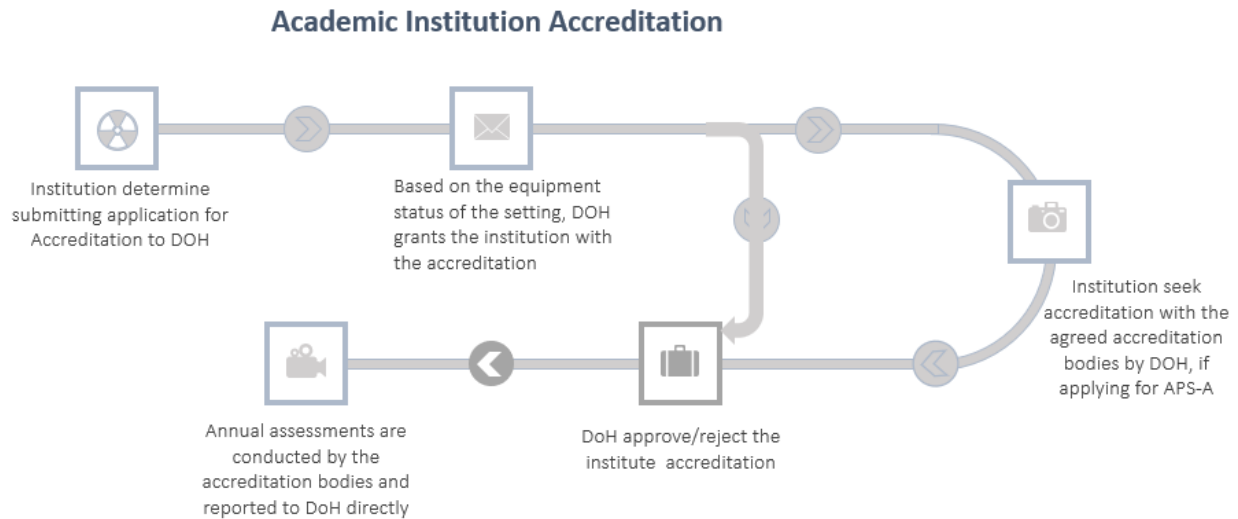
DoH enables academic institutions to provide the world-class standards and highest achievable quality for patients under DOH, healthcare facilities. As described in the table below, there are 3 levels of academic institution, each level is designated with the equipped standard in Medical Education delivery.

The standard for accrediting institutions as teaching facilities, or "the APS levels," are included in the attachment provided along with this manual. These specifications were extracted from the attached herewith the "Set of Standards Healthcare Education Training," which was published in March 2023.



SET of Standards for
Healthcare Education

Beforehand, securing essential preliminary administrative steadiness, educational, financial, and clinical resources are highly important when applying for the accreditation to DoH depending on the APS level, generally like:

- Maintaining Academic space or area for lectures and meetings
- Affiliation with Medical Academic/university
- Institutional equipment per specialty requirement – Surgical PGME program = Theater/OT, and ICU related educational equipment
- Institutional equipment per specialty requirement – Dental PGME = Multidisciplinary dental specialties, including dental radiology room
- Availability of Institutional Policies for staff, equipment manuals, vacation and leaves of absence, including medical, parental, and caregiver leaves, maternity leaves, trainee voluntary withdrawal from program, appealing procedures against any rejection decisions of PD, faculty and trainee, all processes related to reductions and termination, year level repetition policy, major participating





sites, institutional hierarchy, peer and staff organizational policies, in addition to adherence to the below criterion stipulated in the attached “Set of Standards Healthcare Education Training”.

- I. PD selection
- II. Faculty Selection
- III. Institutional coordinator selection

Medical Education Program Accreditation

Medical Education programs require adequate assignments and draw focus attention on quality of patient care with stressing on the learning and working environment, to include case studies to perceive experiences that can include case studies, that dwell on patient safety and health care quality. Upon findings, complaints or monitoring observations of programs, that may indicate any gaps of failure, DoH shall intervene to amend or correct those gaps to ensure continuity of Medical Educational programs ran smooth with success.

Reference to the “set of standards of Healthcare Medical Training” and to maintain the validity of the APS certification and to consider the standards, the Institutional DIO along with the Program Director in APS A and APS I play vital role such as.

- a) Program structure for Internship blocks.
- b) Program structure for residency programs.
- c) Program structure for Fellowship programs.
- d) Maintaining the Exam Board accreditation
- e) Multidisciplinary Healthcare services, or affiliation with interrelated medical specialties
- f) Maintain accreditation as a residency program institution in a specific specialty.
- g) Faculty ratios to participants, based on the specialty program per the ACGME standards.
- h) Formulate and chair Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC);
- i) Who plays important role in collective decision making in trainee cases, committee includes the DIO, PG, residents in advance level and a fellow if applicable, patient safety member and Medical Director of the institution or the facility.
- j) Documented MOM for the 4 quarterly (every three months at least) meetings that take place and are kept for DoH references whenever requested.
- k) The GMEC must demonstrate documented effective oversight of underperforming program(s) through a Special Review process by the committee led by the DIO
- l) Results in a timely report that describes the quality improvement goals, the corrective actions, and the process for GMEC monitoring of outcomes, including timelines.
- m) Conduct and share annual survey results of residents/fellows and core faculty members.
- n) Status of each accredited program including programs underperforming or having faculty turnover
- o) Promoting healthy – wellbeing educational environment for trainees, with valuing their presence and performance in a sophisticated manner
- p) Summary records of institutional performance on indicators in program, trainees and faculty with highlighting any risks are to be maintained, with including challenges with their recommended corrective actions. A bi-annual progressive tracking sheet to be maintained for DoH references.
- q) Corrective action plans are withheld on DIO, on the encountered performance monitoring procedures resulting from the GMEC outcomes.
- r) The Special Review process must include a protocol that establishes a variety of criteria for identifying underperformance that includes, at a minimum, program accreditation statuses of Initial

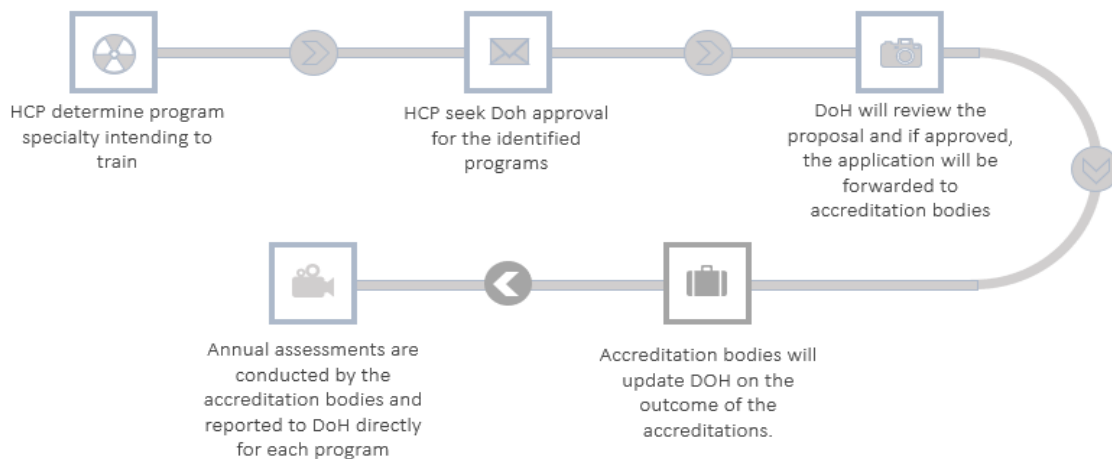




Accreditation with Warning, Continued Accreditation with Warning, and adverse accreditation statuses as per the accreditation and or DOH policies.

- s) Formulate and manage the trainee rotation schedules, between the Emirate institutions and the accredited institutions in the UAE.
- t) Ensuring that trainees get the access to multidisciplinary specialty training for broader learning exploration in the various areas of patient cases.
- u) More importantly, the DIO and the PD play a crucial role in the succession of the programs under their leadership. In order to ensure that programs are jointly overseen by the DIO and PD and that any new topics, challenges, or risks that may arise are reported to and discussed in the PGME Committee, it is imperative that trainers and trainees be continuously managed and supported. Additionally, it is crucial to secure stability and address any concerns or issues beforehand, moreover, assisting important instructors whenever necessary to improve the way the teaching materials are delivered.
- v) Trainees need ongoing assistance and monitoring of their progress toward their learning objectives. It is necessary to document Medical Education programs' governance, structure, and ongoing progress every year to make sure that the improvements and improved conductive procedures are being implemented. The training leadership team's responsibility in academic institutions is to prepare residents to practice with confidence using the highest levels of competences and skills.

Post Graduate Medical Program Accreditation





Medical Education Programs: DOH grants accreditation for any deliverable medical education programs that meet the standard criteria, and these programs are in domains listed below such:

- a) PGME (residency, fellowship)
- b) Internship
- c) Training
- d) CME & CPD

The Medical Education Program domains are defined, in general, by the structure of the programs that are to be delivered, the curriculum, milestones, and competency requirements (upskilling programs), institutional setting, faculty capabilities, and accreditation.

PGME (residency, fellowship), Post Graduate Medical & Dental Education Programs operate within the accredited institutions, the programs currently accredited are of Medicine & Dentistry and in AHP. There are numerous medical residency and fellowship programs, Dental specialties as well as clinical pharmacy and pharmacy-Infectious Disease. Trainee intakes are for professionals with recognized undergraduate qualifications or the related main specialty qualification/s. The program requisitions are board of exam accreditation like Arab Board, Jordan Board, NIHS and Canadian Board. It is worth to mention that the Canadian accredited programs shall allow trainees to have the hybrid training between the two countries, in addition to having the chance in challenging the Canadian board examinations for certifications for those who complete such programs. PGME programs are encouraged to adapt the latest educational milestones with the variety of clinical and research. In addition to residency programs, fellowship programs are post the main specialty programs, and allow the certified professionals in their main specialties to enroll into the fellowship programs on meeting the requirements, for more details on the medical main specialties and sub-specialties, refer to pages 38 to 52 of the PQR.

Internship tends to accommodate certified undergraduate professionals in medical and dentistry (MBBS & BDS). Internship programs are compulsory to be post the undergraduate programs, apart from few local institutions with highly structured academic programs, whose internship programs are carried out within the undergraduate educational program.

Training programs, there are various training programs within this domain that safeguards professionals' competencies prior to contacting patients directly, the purpose of such training is to develop clinical skills for the freshmen into medical practice, re-skill those who have had interruptions in their professions, inspire non-grads into medical educational fields. Within the training programs are observaship training, back to practice, national training and UAE graduates who require training prior to licensing. Nonetheless all these training programs mandate trainees to be registered by DoH prior to commencements to these programs.

CME and CPD programs

Nonetheless, CME and CPD programs can be delivered through DoH accreditation of each program explicitly, moreover, all CME/CPD programs conducted in the geographical areas of Abu Dhabi must have DoH accreditation. Frequency and time-based learning activities that allow licensed HP to maintain and





continue to develop the knowledge, skills, and professional attributes so that they, at all times, remain up-to-date and adequate to the purpose of providing safe, effective and high-quality treatment to patients.

- ❖ CPD training programs
- ❖ CME training Programs
- ❖ Upskilling training programs

Medical Education Participants, DOH sets criterion and requirements of the standard level of trainees enrolling to the programs, types of trainees are defined below. Moreover, all trainees in all levels must either be registered or licensed by DoH prior to enrolling into the programs, shown in the last column the type of approval required to be obtained from DoH.

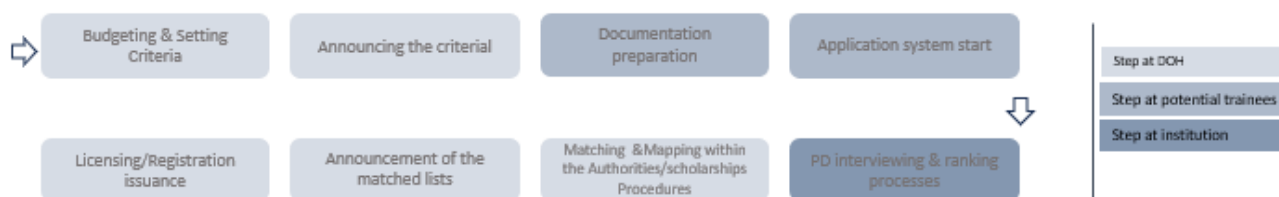

Illustration of the annual cycle consecutive procedural in appointing trainees to the remitted seats for PGME programs. The potential trainees enrolling into internship, residency and fellowship programs are permitted to commence their training on registration approvals granted by DoH.



Below explained processes on the above diagram procedures of PGME program annual cycle processes.

- Pre-cycle commencement, accredited institutions should have prepared their Budgeting Contributing. Moreover, for institutions that have been delivering ME programs, DoH reviews previous outcomes of performance through the data and records maintained, then revisits the next cycle programs that may continue, reduce trainee seats, keep program on hold or terminate the entire program accordingly. As DoH provides the financial support to the accredited institutions to run the programs sustainably, required budget against the potential programs to run for the next cycle shall be secured upon the analysis outcomes; this includes enrolling criteria for trainees, the accredited programs and the allocated seats per each program.
- Announcing the criteria: Annual cycle enrolling criteria in the various academic programs are reviewed and announced to allow competitors to apply for the allocated seats for participant.
- Documentation preparation: Participants prepare the required documents for credentialing and review processes, main requirements are:
- Application system opens for registrations and data entry by applicants: Prerequisites fulfillment and Trainee program/s selection, to up to 3 specialty programs.
- PD/faculty shall interview potential trainees wove met the initial requirements.





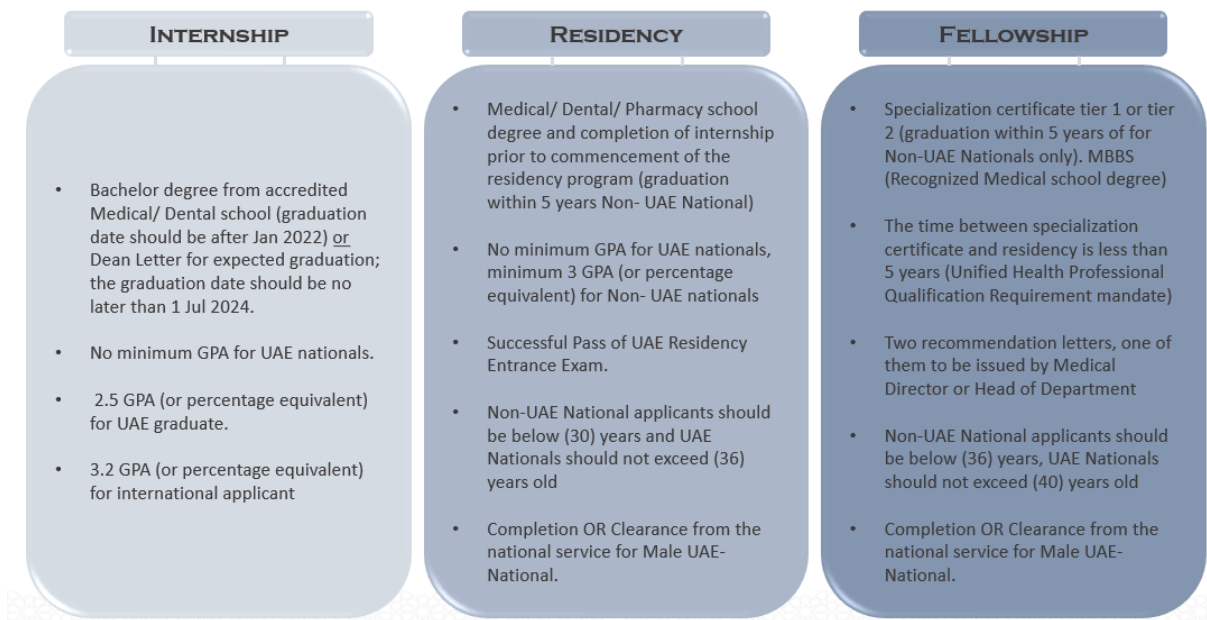
- f. Trainees shall be initially ranked by the PD to the PGME programs they have met the requirements initially.
- g. However, DoH shall apply internal review and evaluations, to validate the ranking and applicant profile levels for allocation as seen appropriate.
- h. Based on the data and records, duplicated data and multiple applications submitted by potential trainees in programs nationally and internationally shall be cleared
- i. Finally, the auto-matching process shall take place per the embedded algorithms, finally Licensing/Registration issuance.
- j. DoH shall however, inscribe as many applicants meeting the requirements as much as possible to ensure that seat capacities are occupied.
- k. Announcement of the matched lists through the official portal of DoH

Correspondingly, PGME program criteria are categorically displayed below, these may require review and updates annually, thus it is strongly advised to ensure you are updated with the information, through our communication channels and DoH portal. Nonetheless, personal identity official documents, personal recent formal photo (passport photo size), curriculum vitae, English proficiency certification (IELTS, Teufel ..etc.), need to be submitted for initial review processes. Trainees are encouraged to select the PGME programs in which they're most passionate to absolute the continuum training in a successful manner. Trainees in advanced training years shall not be allowed to change the specialty programs, to abide by the procedures and allow streamlining and stability of educational programs to proceed. Matching algorithms are configured in a manner of priorities, utmost the passers of the assessments required, then those with highest profiles,
