## 4.2.1 Fee for Service - Special Claiming Rules

## 4.2.1.15 Unified Procurement Program (UPP) for Drugs

Pursuant to the Federal Law No. (8) of 2019, Cabinet Resolution No. (87) of 2023 has been issued on the Formation of the Supreme National Committee for Unified Purchasing to carry out the purchasing process for medicines, medical supplies & equipment and vaccines for all governmental programs. In line with this, the implementation of the Unified Procurement Program for Drugs has been announced through Circular No. USO/144/2024. Accordingly, the following claims and adjudication rules shall apply as part of the implementation of the Unified Procurement Program for Drugs:

- Drugs used in Inpatient and Long Term Care encounters shall be excluded from UPP.
- For encounters other than daycase, only the markup amount shall be reimbursed separately for any single drug given that it meets all regulatory requirements and is included in the UPP.
- For daycase encounters, only the markup amount shall be reimbursed separately for any single drug included in the UPP meeting the threshold of AED 1,000 in accumulative cost as per public drug price given that it meets all regulatory requirements.
- The UPP drugs shall be replenished for the providers at a predetermined frequency based on consumption by the authorized distributor for the UPP.
- The markup amount shall be billed using the appropriate drug code in the DOH Drug list that is accessible through DOH website: <u>Dictionary - Shafafiya | Department of Health Abu</u> <u>Dhabi</u>
- Member Share (co-pays and deductibles) are not affected by the UPP and should be collected as per the drug public price.
- Reimbursement under the government programs shall follow the table below:

For Enhanced health insurance policies, UPP is not applicable and hence dispensing and reimbursing of drugs should continue as per process.
