1. Purpose of this Document.

This addendum is issued to update the definition of Infusions and Injections that can be billed under a daycase encounter type.

3. Claims and Adjudication Rules

4.1.2 Ambulatory Surgical and Medical Procedures

1. **Daycase:** is a beneficiary registered and admitted to a Healthcare facility for purposes of receiving healthcare services in a daycare setting and is not medically expected to remain confined overnight. If this original medical expectation is not fulfilled and the patient stays overnight and in excess of 12 hours, such patients should be then counted as inpatient admissions. In addition, one of the following must also apply:
 - a) Use of a bed for recovery purposes that is, as a result of the patient condition, or following sedation or general anesthesia.
 - b) Minor Surgical and Medical procedures or treatments (only limited to CPT codes Class B and C) as defined below.

1.	Invasive – that is the introduction of an instrument or device that is not a needle, into the body or a body cavity
2.	Endoscopies – the introduction of a scope into the body or body cavity under anesthesia/sedation and/or requires recovery time.
3.	An extracorporeal operation – shock wave treatment Eg: ESWL
4.	Infusions & injections – that requires monitoring and direct supervision of a qualified health practitioner based on medical necessity

2. Effective November 01, 2025, ambulatory surgical and medical procedures shall be billed using the IR-DRG methodology as defined in Section 4.4 for all products.
