4. Claims and Adjudication Rules

4.5.3 Comprehensive screening Codes:

The IFHAS preventive health screening packages shall be reported using service codes 52-41 to 52-65. The screening program codes must be reported only with Encounter Type 7 = Nationals Screening. Refer to the service code table in this addendum for the applicable code description, age group, gender, frequency and included CPT or service components.

- An observation must be reported in the eClaim when using service codes 52-41 to 52-65, as defined in the Routine Reporting Requirements published on <https://www.doh.gov.ae/en/Shafafiya/reporting>.
- For services included within each service code, providers are required to report the relevant CPT or service components as activity lines at claim level and keep the charges for included components at a value of zero.
- All required activities within the applicable screening package must be completed and reported to bill the corresponding service code. Missing activities may be accepted for payment purposes only when clinically justified and properly documented.
- Reimbursement for service codes 52-41 to 52-65 shall not be allowed with separately billed Evaluation and Management or preventive counseling services (CPTs 99202-99215, 99401-99412, 96160, 99381-99387) where the consultation is already included in the package and the services are billed by the same facility for the same patient with the same principal diagnosis on the same date of service.
- The “E&M Follow-up within one week” rule shall not apply to service codes 52-41 to 52-65. Reimbursement may be allowed for a subsequent Evaluation and Management office visit when medically necessary and supported by screening findings or documented clinical need.
- Coding and reimbursement of subsequent diagnostic, counseling, or treatment services shall be based on medical necessity determined by the screening outcome, the documented risk profile, or services prescribed under the applicable DOH comprehensive screening program standard. Whereby,
 - Preventive medicine counseling CPT codes may be reimbursed for patients with established medium- to high-risk factors or abnormal screening findings where counseling is clinically indicated and separately documented.
 - An abnormal finding requires further assessment or management, subsequent encounters shall be billed and reimbursed according to the patient’s medical condition and applicable coding rules, and not as a repeat preventive screening package unless the relevant IFHAS frequency and eligibility requirements are met.

- In case of duplication of tests or screening services between IFHAS and other screening programs under Thiqa within 90 days, the cost of the duplicated service will be subject to recovery.
- Eligibility for the above codes shall follow the DOH comprehensive screening program standard and the package descriptions listed in this addendum.
